

# Grounds Professional Development

## Arborist, Level 2

Chainsaw work, aerial tree work, pruning, dismantling and using appropriate machinery such as brushwood chippers.

## Horticulture or Landscape Construction Operative, Level 2

Building and managing parks, greenspaces and other areas.

## Land-Based Service Engineer, Level 2

Routine maintenance to the repair of elementary mechanical faults

## Sports Turf Operative, Level 2

Sports and venues, including athletics, bowls, cricket, croquet, football, hockey, horse racing, rugby league and union, tennis and ranging from general parks type sports surfaces up to first class stadia.

## Floristry, Level 2

## Horticulture and Landscape Supervisors, Level 3

Oversee work in public parks and gardens, green spaces and historic gardens, private gardens and estates or in production nurseries and retail outlets. Manage a site with minimum supervision, supervise a team and maintain the health and safety and security of personnel and resources.

## Agriculture / Horticulture Professional Advisor, level 6

Agronomist, Nutritionist, Consultant, Crop Consultant, Environmental Specialist

### Level 2 & 3

NVQ, BTEC, Certificate or Diploma (QCF)  
Typical duration 18-24 months

### Level 6

BSc (Hons), Ba, BEng, CILEX, CFA, etc  
Typical duration between 4-6 years
