

### **PINK FORMS AND MODULE ENROLMENT, 2008-9**

Please verify that your details at the top of the page are correct and mark any changes required.

It is *essential* that you enrol on all modules for your programme for the academic year in order to complete your registration for this session. If you have not registered with the University AND enrolled on all your modules by the deadline then you will be de-registered, deemed withdrawn and your IT and other University access will be revoked. You must enrol on all 120 taught credits for the year and details of the requirements of your proposed award – what you must take and where you have choice – are contained in the Programme Specification for your degree. Students should not enrol on more than 120 credits in any academic session.

You should receive in your registration pack a list of the modules to which you have been allocated and we will give you all the other details that you need to complete the form. Your personal tutor (whose details you will find on the list of modules in your registration pack) must verify and SIGN this form for it to be validated. For combined honours students, each line must be initialled by the department which “owns” the module in order to authorise your choice.

The PINK form must be returned to your School Office (and in the case of Combined Honours students to the first named department in your degree title) **no later than 4.00 p.m. on Friday 3 October 2008** of registration week in order to secure your choices.

If you are having difficulty in completing this form then please see Jay Pengelly for help. The ADD/DROP period for you to make changes to your initial module enrolments closes at 4.00 p.m. on Friday 5 October 2007.
