

POSTER SUBMISSION

BRIEF

Create a poster about the benefits (e.g. educational or employability-related, or both!) that you have gained by being a Peer Mentor. Your poster will be showcased at the University of Exeter's Education Conference in the summer.

You can create the poster alone, in a pair or trio (just be sure to include the names of all contributors on the poster and ensure each contributor uploads it to their own workflow).

FORMAT

Start your poster on one of the PowerPoint templates provided, feel free to change anything but ensure the slide size remains the same - A1).

Font sizes:

- Title: 85
- Subheadings: 36
- Body text: 24
- Captions: 28

WHAT MAKES A GOOD POSTER?

- A mixture of brief text, pictures, tables and other presentation formats.
- Important information should be readable from about 10 feet away.
- Title is short and draws interest.
- Word count of around 300 - 800 words.
- Text is clear and to the point.
- Effective use of graphics, colour and fonts.
- Consistent and clean layout.

CONTENT

The posters will be about the educational and/or employability-related benefits that you have gained by being a Peer Mentor.

Some questions to help stimulate your thoughts:

- What have you particularly enjoyed about being a Peer Mentor?
- Has Mentoring enhanced your academic studies? Has it embedded your own learning? Consolidated your knowledge? Developed academic skills?
- Has it created a sense of belonging in your discipline or college? Has it made you feel like part of a community?
- Has being a Peer Mentor had a positive impact on your educational experience at Exeter?
- How has Mentoring enhanced your employability? Developed transferable skills? Have any 'STAR' examples?
