

Flexibility is at the heart of ADIT, both in the way it's structured and your study options.

To ensure you have a robust foundation knowledge, but can tailor ADIT to your particular requirements or ambitions, flexibility is built in. All students are required to take the 'Principles of International Taxation' module to attain a thorough grounding in the key issues of the moment, before focusing on the tax regimes of particular countries, or themes in international tax. If you have a very specific interest in a particular area of tax or jurisdiction, you can choose to write an extended essay in place of one of the modules.

Works with your time commitments

Modules are examined twice a year around the world and are offered in both on-screen and handwritten formats. You can take all three modules at the same time, or one at a time – whatever suits you best.

You also have five years to complete ADIT. But if you find yourself at the end of that time with modules left to take, you simply need to re-register. To ensure that your knowledge is up-to-date, any modules passed more than five years previously will need to be retaken.
