What you might want to bring:

Alarm clock and personal effects	
Bedding, including pillows and a duvet - available from <u>Click2Campus</u> or local shops. Check the mattress sizes in your residence before buying!	
Bike and bike lock	
Cleaning products for your room, en-suite and kitchen (where applicable)	
Coat hangers	
Computer/laptop	
Electrical appliances under 1200 watts in power* (eg hairdryers, stereos)	
Extension leads for power and Ethernet connections and UK adaptors if required*	
Formal photo identification, eg passport or driving license – this is needed to allow you to collect your key/fob	
Kitchen utensils – cutlery, crockery, pots and pans, chopping board, glasses etc.	
An iron – though you can buy these locally. Communal ironing boards are available	
Pins for your pinboard - there are poster sales on campus throughout the year	
Stationery - the campus shops will also sell stationery, as will shops in town	
Towels and tea towels	
TV license (if you plan on watching live TV via your PC or laptop – aerial sockets are not provided in all study bedrooms)	
Washing powder and laundry bin - for your laundry	

We provide:

Curtains – all study bedrooms are equipped with flame retardant curtains which should not be replaced with your own

Cleaning equipment such as vacuum cleaners, irons etc – you will have access to communal equipment

Desk lighting – this is provided in your room, with the exception of Rowancroft en-suite and studio rooms

The following items are not permitted:

Any additional furniture or coat rails, unless required for medical reasons and pre-agreed with AccessAbility

Candles, incense or any open flame device

Electrical appliances over 1200 watts in power
