# A PIONEERING PARTNERSHIP TO ENHANCE YOUR UNIVERSITY EXPERIENCE

Welcome to the Tremough Campus, a 100 acre, £200M Higher Education hub that is shared and jointly managed by the University of Exeter (UoE) and University College Falmouth (UCF).

During the past decade, as a result of sustained investment, UCF and UoE have developed a pioneering partnership to deliver buildings, facilities and services at Tremough (and UCF's Woodlane Campus).

This successful partnership is now being taken to another level with the expansion of its joint venture, the Tremough Campus Services Group (TCSG). TCSG is exclusively owned by UoE and UCF on a 50:50 basis, and has charitable status.

TCSG is responsible for delivering four clusters of activity: Estates & Development Services, Academic Services, Student Support Services and Campus Services, underpinned by close collaboration with the students' union, FXU and all staff, to ensure that your interests are at the heart of everything we do.

As well as aiming to provide world-class buildings, facilities and services, TCSG will maximise opportunities to generate income through a fifth External Income cluster. This will focus on hiring out our facilities and services to external organisations for events and conferences, particularly during the summer. The income generated in this way will be continually reinvested in facilities and services for the future, benefiting all students and staff.


