Quiet/silent study spaces

Devonshire House (2), Junior Common Room, 1st Floor – 30 quiet/silent study seats

Main Library (4) – 111 silent/quiet study (270 seats in total)*

Research Commons, Old Library (7) – 186 silent/quiet study seats

Arab World Documentation Unit, IAIS (16) – 16 quiet study seats

Law Library, Amory (29), Level I – 210 quiet study seats (323 seats in total)

Additional spaces are normally available between 9am and 5pm in public areas of Hope, Mardon, Holland and Lopes Halls. Queen's Building, rooms Ib and Ig, will be available during the summer term.

Study space with PC provision

Main Library (4) – 98 PC seats

Research Commons, Old Library (7) – 18 PC seats

- Room 0.31 32 PC seats




Research Commons, Old Library (7) – open until 9pm weekdays in term-time
