Please note that these opportunities are for overseas academics who have links with Fudan instead of Exeter academics exclusively. Subjects: Sciences, engineering, medicines and social sciences (Please note that academics are not eligible if their Fudan hosts come from humanities subjects such as Language, Literature, History, Philosophy, etc.)

Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The applicants who have won Nobel Prize, Turing award, Fields Medal, or other same-level awards, are suggested applying for Honorary Fudan Scholar. ▪ The applicants who have been recommended having the potential to win the aforementioned awards, including the academicians of a country/region or the distinguished scientists winning the same-level honors, are suggested applying for Distinguished Fudan Scholar. ▪ The applicants who are less than 35 years old and have prominent scientific research potential, such as post-doctors, are suggested applying for Fudan Scholar. ▪ The applicants who have the experience of working in a government or international organizations, famous enterprises, as well as the ability of advanced exchange and research, are suggested applying for suitable levels based on their personal conditions.

Field of study	Social Sciences (political science, sociology, economics, environment, finance, and other fields of social sciences)
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants must be or under 55 years of age. • Applicant should hold a faculty position at a recognized university or be a regular member at an established research institute outside Mainland China. • Research interest could be one of the following fields: political science, sociology, economics, environment, finance, and other fields of social sciences. • Preference will be given to applicants whose research is policy-oriented.
Visit Duration	30 to 90 days
Tasks/ Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visiting Scholars are responsible for conducting their own research independently on the topics related to one of the themes below. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - China's Development (Applicant who applies to conduct research under this theme should have received a doctoral degree) - Global Governance • All Visiting Scholars are required to submit a final report on the outcome of their research. • Visiting scholars are required to submit a working paper or comment each month. • Visiting Scholars are required to work during office hours at the FDDI office for at least 2 days per week. During this period, Visiting Scholars will meet with scholars, staff or students who have made an appointment with them. • Visiting scholars should make at least one presentation on his/her research topic. • Visiting Scholars are required to provide at least 1 article on China studies for FDDI publications. They could either submit works of their own or recommend qualified articles from others. • All the reports/ articles/ essays that Visiting Scholars submit to FDDI will be selected and recommended to FDDI publishing partners. Please ensure that the reports/articles/essays that you submit or recommend do not cause any copyright conflicts.

Subsidy for living expenses: ¥ 300.00 RMB/day. • Visiting Scholars enjoy full access to libraries and electronic resources at Fudan University. • The FDDI provides each Visiting Scholar with free office space which is accessible from Monday to Friday, 8:30 – 17:00 p.m. (except for University holidays). • Visiting Scholars are welcome to attend lectures and all public scholarly events

Funding body	Foreign Affairs Office
Field of study	humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, technology and engineering, life sciences and medical sciences
Eligibility	Fudan Fellow Program accepts full-time Associate Professor and Professor . The Program does not award an academic diploma. All applicants shall: 1. Have an on-going research project, 2. Have a good command of working languages to interact with Fudan community where Chinese and English are most spoken, 3. Be a citizen of a foreign country and holds a full-time position in a foreign institute.
Visit Duration	4-16 weeks
Tasks/ Requirements	For every four weeks on campus, fellows are asked to give at least one lecture, either to students or fellow researches, or to host workshops and seminars. Fellows are encouraged to publish papers after the fellowship is completed under the title of Fudan Fellow. A copy of the publication shall be presented and kept by Fudan University.
Funding amount/ resources	1. Accommodation on or near campus will be provided during the fellowship. 2. International round-trip air fare will be reimbursed upon application by the fellow. 3. A monthly stipend of RMB ¥15,000 will be granted for Associate Professors and Professors.
Application deadline	Application for 2019 round is not open yet. The application window for the 2018 visits was Dec 12, 2017-Jan 14, 2018. Interested academics are advised to follow the web link closely.
Application materials	All applications are subject to Fudan Fellow Program Academic Committee and are considered on a case-by-case basis. Applications shall include: 1. Application Form, 2. Curriculum vitae that includes education background, research experience and publications, 3. Research proposal.

Funding body	International Centre for Studies of Chinese Civilization
Field of study	Humanistic research on Chinese civilization
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants must usually be under 50 years of age and have strong academic research ability. • Applicant should hold a faculty position at a recognized university or an established research institute outside China. • Applicant should hold a PhD degree from an overseas university. • Applicant should conduct humanistic research on Chinese civilization. Preference will be given to applicants whose research is on traditional Chinese civilization.
Visit Duration	1 month, 3 months, or 6 months. (Non-Chinese passport holders are advised to apply for a visit within 90 days due to the F visa regulation.)
Tasks/ Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The visiting scholar shall have a cooperative scholar in China during his/her visit. • Visiting scholars should co-organize a workshop with the center during their visit. The number of participants of the workshop is usually 12, excluding the visiting scholar and his/her cooperative scholar, consisting of domestic and overseas academics in the research area. The center will cover travel cost, accommodation and food for the participants. The center reserves the right to publish the collected papers of the workshop. • Visiting scholars shall make at least one academic report during their visit. The paper of the report shall be submitted to the center as the results of the visit. • On the occasion that visiting scholars are invited to participate in academic activities held by organisations other than the center during their visit, they should be explicitly referred as "visiting scholars of International Center for Studies of Chinese Civilization of Fudan University" in any information about the activities. • Any publication of the research conducted or the academic achievements achieved by the visiting scholars during their visit shall acknowledge the support from International Center for Studies of Chinese Civilization of Fudan University.
Funding amount/ resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The center will provide one round-trip international air fare, accommodation and research allowance for visiting scholars. • Visiting scholars may use the research room, reception room, conference room, computer printing equipment, books and materials provided by the center during their visit. • The center will provide necessary academic, logistical and administrative support to visiting scholars, in order to encourage them to carry out academic seminars, lectures and other academic activities, and to facilitate academic exchanges and collaborated research between visiting scholars and Fudan academics and students. • The center will issue letters of introduction or other supporting documents to facilitate visiting scholars with access to documents, literatures and other

	materials and to facilitate their communication with academics in other academic institutions in China during their stay.
Application deadline	Application is open now - open all year round. There are two deadlines for autumn and spring visits: April 30th and October 31st respectively.
Application materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Curriculum vitae that includes education background, research experience and publications, • A research proposal during the visit (No less than 3,000 words in Chinese, or no less than 5 pages in English) • Two letters of recommendation by experts in the research area from home and abroad. <p>The materials can be in Chinese or in English.</p>

Programme name: Teaching Opportunity at Fudan Intensive Summer Teaching (FIST)

Funding body	Graduate School
Field of study	No specific requirement.
Eligibility	<p>Courses need to be introduction to the frontiers of scientific research, methodological research, special report on certain subjects, interdisciplinary, etc., and shall be suitable for intensive teaching to postgraduates. [A list of courses run in 2017 for reference: http://www.gs.fudan.edu.cn/c2/be/c2889a115390/page.htm (in Chinese only)]</p> <p>For the each FIST application in the 2018 round: At least one out of the three academics needed to be Nobel Prize winner, Fields Prize winner, CAS academician, CAE academician, Distinguished Professor of Changjiang Scholars Programme, or other distinguished professors, etc. At least one out the three academics needed to be Fudan academic.</p>
Visit Duration	No specific requirement. 2017 info for reference: courses run from 4 to 25 days, depending on number of teachers in the project, credits of the courses, etc.
Tasks/ Requirements	Teaching. Seminars - optional, depending on the organisation by Fudan coordinators.
Funding amount/ resources	Not released for the 2019 round yet. For the 2018 round: RMB 30,000 - 60,000 for each FIST project. It's up to Fudan coordinators how many teachers they were inviting for the projects and how the money was allocated. The transportation fees for all overseas academics should not exceed RMB 20,000 and the total honorarium should not exceed RMB21,000 (pre-tax).
Application deadline	Application is not open yet. 2018 round for reference: application deadline was April 10, 2018. Interested Exeter academics are advised to discuss with their Fudan academic partners re application.
