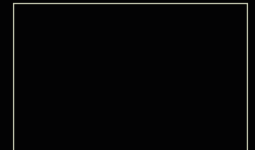

[▲]based on percentage of research rated 3* and 4* (internationally excellent or world leading)

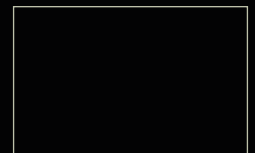
Exeter is also top 10 in the Sunday Times 2012 and Guardian 2013 league tables.
