



Health Insurance

Due to stringent U.S. Health Insurance requirements, USM *strongly* encourage students to opt for Southern Miss health insurance upon arrival.

Premiums for 2010/11 are \$622 for the Fall Semester, and \$862 for the Spring Semester or \$1484 for the academic year.
