

## Student visas

To gain a UK Tier 4 visa, students must show that they have enough funds for both academic and living expenses. The UKVI stipulate the amount that unaccompanied applicants will need to show for living expenses at any University outside London. At the time of writing (July 2017) this was £9,135 (£1,015 per month). The actual cost of living may differ depending on accommodation costs and lifestyle choices. Students who do not meet our entry requirements may be considered for an INTO University of Exeter Foundation or International Year One

Candidates with a minimum of 4 out of 5 GPA in the Secondary School Certificate – Grade 11 (Attestat), will be considered for admission to Foundation courses at the INTO Exeter centre with assured progression to Bachelor degree courses if sufficient grades are attained. Applicants must have 4.0 out of 5.0 in Maths for Business, Science or Engineering Foundation programmes.
