USE AND PARKING OF BICYCLES

- 1. This policy applies to students, staff and visitors to the Exeter campuses who are hereby notified that all bicycles parked on University property are parked at their owner's risk.
- **2.** Cyclists are required to observe and comply with the regulations concerning the movement of traffic on the University's campuses.
- **3.** Cycling on footpaths and grassed areas on the University's campuses is prohibited.
- **4.** Bicycles should be parked in designated areas where stands or other facilities are provided.
- 5. Under no circumstances may bicycles be taken into buildings or parked where they are liable to cause obstruction, likely to cause danger, attached to railings at entrances to buildings, other street furniture or otherwise defacing the University.
- **6.** Bicycles which are found in buildings or parked where they are liable to cause obstruction or danger may, without notice, be removed or impounded. Security chains and other devices will be cut if necessary.
- 7. Notices will be affixed to bicycles/locking devices thought to have been abandoned. After 28 days, bicycles deemed to have been abandoned on University property may be removed and donated to charity in accordance with the Abandoned Bikes policy.
- **8.** Cycles stored in University residential areas must be registered with the relevant Halls of Residence and removed at the end of residency. Failure to do so without prior exception may result in removal.
