

Moving In Checklist

Identification and documentation:

- Photographic identification e.g. passport or driving licence
- A passport-sized photo of yourself
- Important documents e.g. student finance, bank details, acceptance letter/s

TV Licence (if you plan on watching live TV via pc/laptop– aerial sockets are not provided in all study bedrooms)

For your accommodation:

- Bedding: duvet and cover/s, pillows and cases, sheets (we recommend non-fitted), mattress protector.
- Toiletries: toothbrush and paste, towels, soap/shower gel, deodorant, brush etc.
- Clothing and other personal items
- Coat hangers
- Computer/laptop and printer (if required)
- Electrical appliances*. Please check if you intend to bring a hairdryer to ensure it is under 1200 watts as otherwise it will be too powerful for the socket and you will not be able to use it.
- Extension leads for power and Ethernet connections
- UK plug adaptors (if required)
- Chargers for electrical items
- Bike and bike lock if desired
- Catered accommodation only: Kettle
- Self catered accommodation only: Cooking utensils for yourself e.g. saucepan, frying pan, sharp knife, baking tray · Plates, bowls, glasses, mugs and cutlery.

Items you may want to buy on arrival and/or share the cost of with flatmates:

- Clothes horse/dryer
- Laundry basket and washing powder for laundry
- Bottle opener/corkscrew, garlic crusher, tin opener, chopping boards, colander, cheese grater
- Cleaning products for your room, bathroom and kitchen (cleaning equipment including vacuum cleaner, mop and bucket, iron and ironing board are provided)

Prohibited items:

- Additional furniture/coat rails (unless required for medical reasons and pre-agreed with AccessAbility)
- Candles, incense or any open flame devices

*All students' electrical equipment must be safe and in particular:

- Be CE marked
- Have a sound mains lead and plug
- Be correctly rated for fuses fitted for the appliance
- Not be used in combination which overloads the electricity supply
