

MOVING IN CHECKLIST - ITEMS TO BRING

DOCUMENTS

- Photographic identification e.g. passport, driving licence (essential)
- Important documents such as: bank details, visas, university student finance/ acceptance letters
- TV Licence (for info go to tvlicensing.co.uk)
*check first if you need a TV Licence
- Medical documents (if required), prescription medication
- Any other important university and personal documents

SELF-CATERED & CATERED BEDROOM AND BATHROOM ESSENTIALS



- Duvet, pillows, duvet cover, pillow cases, sheet (non-fitted), blanket/throw
- Towels, toiletries e.g. toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, deodorant etc.
- Coat hangers
- Extension lead (UK plug adaptor if required), appliance charging equipment
- Cleaning products and cleaning cloths
- Laundry basket/hamper/laundry powder/ detergent
- Toilet roll



Ensure you choose the correct bedding size for your residence e.g. single or double.

- Portable heaters/fan heaters
- Candles/incense
- Electric blanket
- Additional furniture
- Any type of adhesive fixings e.g. coat hooks
