- **How do I apply for Green Consultants?**

You can apply using an application form. Applications will be open in September.

- **Where is the training carried out?**

The training is delivered online. Most will be for you to do at a time to suit you, but some will be time-constrained or group work.

- **What does the on-campus project entail of?**

All the on-campus projects are different. All projects will be linked in some way to the University of Exeter Climate Emergency White Paper. . Our most recent projects looked at food waste in catered halls, the University's place in global sustainability rankings and integrating sustainability learning into every student's experience. With such a wide range of different on-campus projects there will always be new interesting projects that you'll be interested in. You will be working as part of a group.

- **Is the 35 hours for the on-campus project per group?**

No, each student is required to carry out 35 hours. Depending on the group sizes different projects will have different total project hours.

- **Do I have to be studying an environmental degree?**

No, all students from any degree programme are welcome to apply for the programme. Having awareness for sustainability and being environmentally conscious will definitely help you through your application.

- **Do I automatically get the internship once I've carried out the programme?**

If you have completed the online training and the on-campus project, we will do all we can to access an internship for you.

- **Do I get a choice in the internship that I carry out?**

Where possible we will take your interests and preferences into account, but we cannot guarantee the internship of your choice.
