

**INVENTORY OF ROMAN POTTERY  
FROM SITES EXCAVATED IN  
EXETER 1980-90**

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## 1. INTRODUCTION

This report comprises a nearly complete inventory of Roman pottery found on the fifteen sites with Roman remains excavated in Exeter between the years 1980 to 1990.

The entire amphorae details from Bartholomew Street East, Friernhay Street, St Nicholas Priory and Paul Street have been mislaid. Rather than wait for the vessels to be re-examined it has been decided to publish this report now and incorporate the missing data when it is available. The details contained within this volume serve as a companion to the Exeter Museums Archaeological Field Unit Report *Roman Pottery From Exeter 1980-1990* (Holbrook, N. & Bidwell, P.T. 1992, EMAFU Report 92.30); readers should refer to this for an updated discussion on fabric and forms mentioned. For a full discussion see *Roman Finds From Exeter* (Holbrook, N. & Bidwell, P.T. 1991, Exeter Archaeological Reports 4).

## 2. THE SITES EXCAVATED

## 3. LAYOUT OF INVENTORY

The sites are set out chronologically in the order in which they were excavated. Excluded were those sites where there were only a few isolated Roman features, these can be found within the miscellaneous section at the end of this report (p. 104). Each individual site is set out in context numerical order, with context numbers emboldened, followed by a context date, where known. Context dating abbreviations are as follows:



Mil = Roman Military (c.AD 55/60-75/80).

Civ = Roman Civil.

PRDS = Post Roman Dark Soils.

In the mid 1970's one of the authors (Bidwell) designated certain fabric-types by a number (where origins and attributions were uncertain). These designations were instituted for cataloguing purposes. This system was expanded upon in the 1980's by Holbrook for all fabric-types for a now defunct pottery database. The system has been retained here in order to save space and to facilitate the presentation of the data; it will also prove useful if the pottery database is revived. Therefore, all fabrics are set out in numerical order.

Total weights (Wt) per fabric, where relevant, are given in grams. Vessel types, where identified, are quantified by estimated rim equivalents (ERE) expressed as a percentage. Vessel forms, as designated in the fabric-type series found in *Roman Finds from Exeter* (Holbrook, N. & Bidwell, P.T. 1991), are set out in numerical sequence. In some circumstances only a general vessel description (e.g. beaker) has been given. Therefore, an abbreviated alphabetical notation system (e.g. BKR = Beaker) has been used. This is set out in alphabetical order and follows after the numerical sequence. See glossary (p. 004) for both type abbreviations and fabric number definitions. In addition, information concerning vessel dates, descriptive notes and figure numbers (illustrated in EMAFU report 92.30) are provided in brackets. Also included in brackets are notes on the relevant fabric or context.

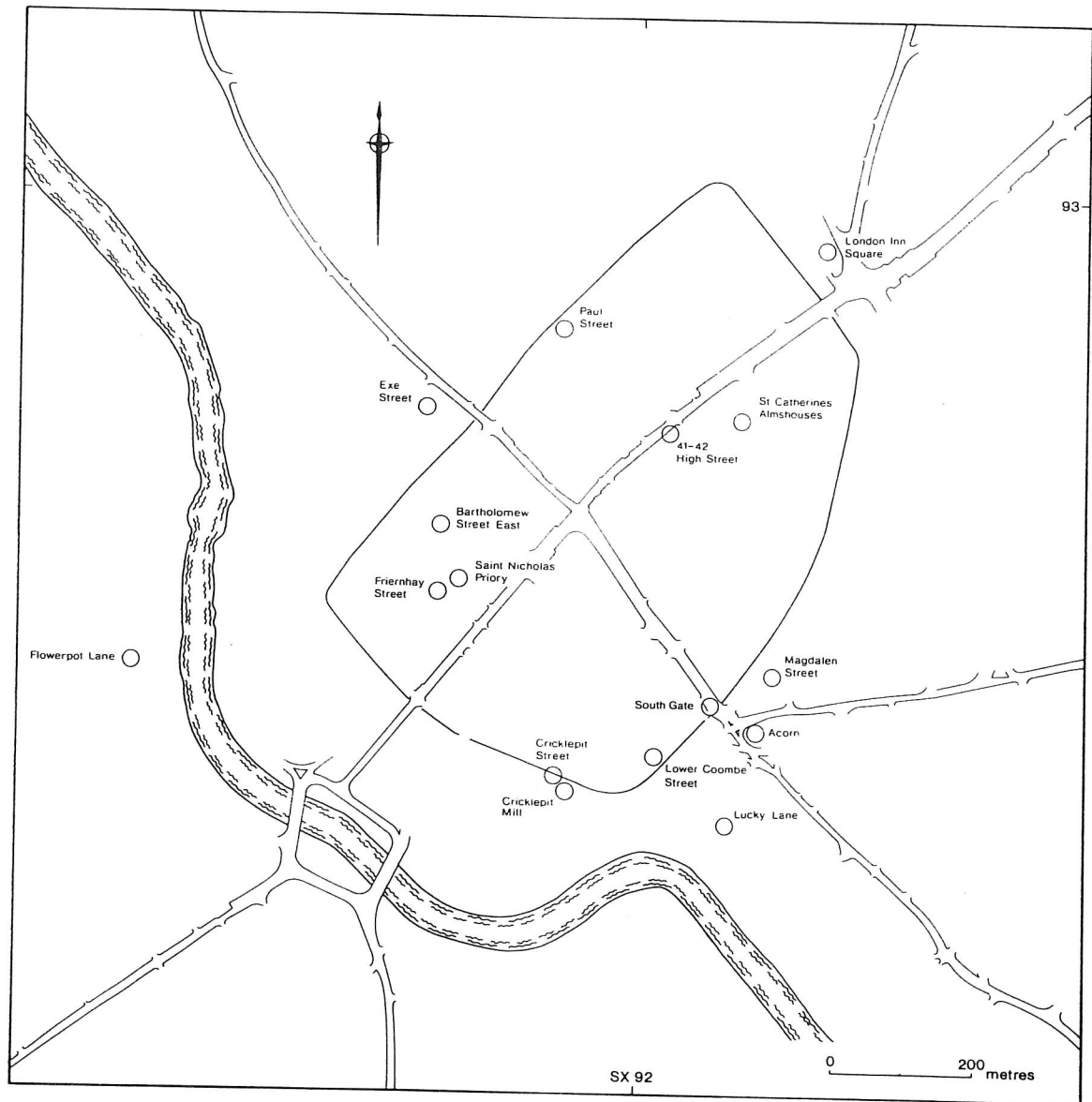


Fig. 1 Location of sites with Roman remains. 1980-1990 (with the exception of London Inn Square: residual pottery only).
