



Information for new University of Exeter international students

Welcome. We are looking forward to seeing you in Exeter. You may have travelled in the UK before but just in case you haven't please find following some travel information for getting to Exeter.

Travelling from London Heathrow to Exeter:

By rail – via London Paddington Station:

Take the Heathrow Express train to London Paddington Station. Tickets cost £22.00 and can be purchased from the ticket office. The journey takes 15 minutes and trains leave every 15 minutes. Last train is at 23.12 from Terminal 5.

When you get to London Paddington, go to the ticket office in the main forecourt and ask for a 'single ticket' (one way ticket) to **Exeter St David's** train station. A 'single' will cost from £39.00 - £118. The journey will take approximately 2.5 hours. The last quick train leaves at approximately 20.03 (arriving 22.34) on Saturday and 21:03 (arriving 23:20) on Sunday. Later trains arrive early in the morning.

By bus from Heathrow Airport;

Follow the signs in the arrival hall to the airport's Central Bus Station. Buy a National Express single ticket from the Ticket Office located by WH Smith Bookshop near Stand 1 to Exeter (Honiton Road). A single will cost c.£30.00. Journey time is approximately 4.5 hours. *Please note places are limited and there are strict limits on your luggage:*

Information for new University of Exeter and Falmouth University international students travelling to Penryn.

Welcome! We are looking forward to seeing you in Cornwall. You may have travelled in the UK before but just in case you haven't please find following some travel information for getting to the Penryn Campus in Cornwall.

Travelling from London Heathrow to Penryn:

By rail – via London Paddington Station:

Take the Heathrow Express train to London Paddington Station. Tickets cost £25.00 and can be purchased from the ticket office. The journey takes 15 minutes and trains leave every 15 minutes. Last train is at 23.42.

When you get to London Paddington, go to the ticket office in the main forecourt and ask for a 'single ticket' (one way ticket) to **Penryn** train station. You will need to change trains at least once in Truro. You will need to take a taxi from Penryn to campus (call 0044(0) 1326 373007). The total journey will take approximately 5 hours.

By bus:

Follow the signs in the arrival hall to the airport's Central Bus Station. Buy a National Express single ticket from the Ticket Office located by WH Smith Bookshop near Stand 1 to Falmouth Bus Station. A single will cost £37. Journey time is approximately 8 hours. *Please note places are limited and there are strict limits on your luggage.* Once you arrive in Falmouth, take a U1, U2 or U3 bus to the Penryn campus, or catch a taxi from the taxi rank opposite the bus stops.

In case of emergency please call the university on 01326 253503. Please tell them that you are an international student.

Exeter rail or bus station to campus

When you arrive at Exeter St David's there is a taxi rank outside the station. You can also call Apple Taxis (01392 666666) if you arrive at Honiton Bus Station. If you have university accommodation, follow their instructions for key collection. If you are in any doubt about where to collect your key please ask the taxi driver to take you to Northcote House and wait while you speak to Estate Patrol.

If you are in university accommodation you will receive a Welcome Pack which has lots of information in it, including an events programme. You will collect your pack with your accommodation keys or from the Guild Information Point in Devonshire House if you are living in private accommodation. International Student Support are based at the Forum from Monday to Friday this week. We look forward to seeing you.
