The University of Exeter founded the Institute of Cornish Studies in 1970 and has had a presence in Cornwall since the Camborne School of Mines merged with the University in 1993.

In order to meet the need for higher education in Cornwall and help raise the aspirations of its youth population, the Penryn and Truro campuses were opened in 2004.


The intervening years have seen over 6,000 students achieve their goals, donning robes for their graduation ceremonies in Truro Cathedral.

Our world-leading research and teaching excellence has attracted people from all over the world to make Cornwall their home. We employ over 600 staff and currently have around 2,500 students studying across both campuses.

We have developed an international reputation as the pre-eminent research institute in Cornwall by collaborating with local stakeholders to undertake cutting-edge research addressing scientific, medical, and social concerns.

Together with our campus partners, we are helping to transform the local economy and to make Cornwall more competitive. We have created many high-skilled jobs – one of the main reasons our local community enjoys the lowest unemployment rates and highest average wages in the Duchy.

We are proud of all that we have achieved here and intend to build on this success in the future.

- We are a member of the prestigious Russell Group of research-intensive universities.
- We engage and raise the aspirations of thousands of school children by holding outreach events, such as Science in the Square, and by hosting ceremonies for Children's University and the Excellence Awards.
- We work with over 80 Widening Participation students from schools in Cornwall and Devon on our Exeter Progression Programme, which provides two years of support prior to their applying to university, and a preferential offer from us if they choose to apply to the University of Exeter. We also host a summer residential with BAME students from London and Birmingham.
- Collaboration with Cornwall Sports Partnership has led to our sponsorship of the Cornwall School Games for a four year period to encourage young people in Cornwall to engage more with physical exercise and school sport.
- TEF Gold award for teaching excellence consistently delivering outstanding teaching, learning and outcomes for our students.
- The CWTS Leiden Ranking 2019 positions Exeter 24th in the world, 9th in Europe and 7th in the UK for the quality of its research publications.
- The latest Research Excellence Framework (REF 2014) recognised 98% of our research as being of international quality.
- We are consistently ranked within the top 15 universities in the UK.
- Our Innovation, Impact and Business team offer unique access to collaborative research and development, innovation, facilities and expertise that can make a real difference to your business. 
