Key aims

- To support members to realise their potential by providing opportunities that they do not currently have access to

- To help nurture and facilitate greater engagement across researchers and the wider research community, regionally and nationally
- To draw on the Academy's unique ability to convene and nurture intersectoral collaboration to create unique opportunities for researchers.

Who is the Network for?

To join the Network in the first two years, you should:

- Identify as an ECR with a background in a humanities or social sciences discipline
- Usually be within 10 years of your PhD or equivalent doctoral experience.

This initial two-year phase of the Network is also limited to ECRs who meet the above requirements and either:

- Have currently or previously received British Academy funding or funding from an approved partner
- Are affiliated with a research institution within the Midlands, Southwest or Scotland.

What makes us different?

The Network brings together almost 2,000 ECRs across the humanities and social sciences bridging important gaps between those ECRs who have security and funding and those who do not.

Network members:

- Inform, shape and feed into the activities of the Network
- Develop their own sessions with support from the Academy and/or Hub partners
- Access our community platform to expand their networks and links with researchers, Fellows and partners
- Access online and in person events, workshops and training
- Access networking opportunities that expand networks and encourage cross collaboration.
