

University of Exeter Alumni Scholarship and Class of 2020 Progression Award with the Global Commitment uplift 2020/21

For 2020/21 the Alumni and Progression Scholarships have been increased through the addition of the Global Commitment Scholarship. Together these awards are worth 20% of the tuition fee for students enrolling on a standalone postgraduate taught Masters or research (MPhil/PhD) programme of study in 2020/21, with the exception of PGCE programmes.

Awards are available to all domestic and international University of Exeter alumni and finalists who have:

- graduated from an undergraduate or postgraduate degree awarded by the University of Exeter
- completed an inbound Study Abroad semester/year at the University of Exeter
- completed a credit-bearing University of Exeter International Summer School

The scholarship will be automatically applied to eligible postgraduate applicants enrolling for study in 2020/21. A separate application is not required. The scholarship will be awarded as a reduction in tuition fees; it cannot be paid as cash or attributed to other charges such as accommodation fees. It will be automatically deducted from your first year tuition fees upon enrolment. This award is not recurrent for subsequent years of study.

Ordinarily you cannot receive more than one scholarship from the University of Exeter, with the exception of any Prompt Payment Reward to which you might be eligible. If you are eligible for multiple scholarships you will be awarded whichever scholarship has the higher value. However, for 2020/21 a further exception has been applied to the Global Commitment Scholarship, which can also be held in conjunction with another University-funded scholarship. For simplicity, the Global Commitment Scholarship has been added to the Alumni and Progression Scholarships to create an award worth 20% of tuition fees.

If you choose to pay your tuition fees in instalments, the award will be deducted from the total annual tuition fee and the remaining balance split accordingly. If your tuition fees will be financed by an external body (such as an overseas government or Chevening, Commonwealth or a partner Institution with whom the University has a shared financing agreement), this award may be invalidated or superseded with a different fee arrangement. It is your responsibility to inform us if you are in receipt of any external funding prior to enrolment; please send a soft copy of the award letter to admissions pg-ad@exeter.ac.uk.

If you defer your 2020/21 offer then your scholarship offer will be invalidated. In the event that you withdraw or interrupt your studies post enrolment then the University Finance regulations at that date will apply as regards any repayment or other requirements:
