

Global Commitment Scholarship 2020/21

The Global Commitment Scholarship 2020/21 of £2,000 is available to International students enrolling on a standalone postgraduate taught Masters or research (MPhil/PhD) programme of study in 2020/21, excluding the following non-standard courses, and those delivered by a partner business or other institution:

- PGCE
- Degree Apprenticeships
- MSc Island Biodiversity and Conservation
- LLB Graduate Law
- Legal Practice Course (LPC)
- Graduate Diploma in Law (GDL)
- MA Education (online)

The scholarship will be automatically applied to eligible postgraduate applicants enrolling for study beginning in the 2020/21 academic year. A separate application is not required. The scholarship will be awarded as a reduction in tuition fees; it cannot be paid as cash or attributed to other charges such as accommodation fees. It will be automatically deducted from your first year tuition fees upon enrolment. This award is not recurrent for subsequent years of study.

Ordinarily you cannot receive more than one scholarship from the University of Exeter, with the exception of any Prompt Payment Reward to which you might be eligible. However, for 2020/21 a further exception has been applied to the Global Commitment Scholarship, which can also be held in conjunction with another University-funded scholarship. If you choose to pay your tuition fees in instalments, the award will be deducted from the total annual tuition fee and the remaining balance split accordingly. If you are eligible for multiple scholarships, you will be awarded whichever scholarship has the higher value and then the Global Commitment Scholarship will be added on top.

If your tuition fees will be financed by an external body (such as an overseas government or Chevening, Commonwealth or a partner Institution with whom the University has a shared financing agreement), this award may be invalidated or superseded with a different fee arrangement. It is your responsibility to inform us if you are in receipt of any external funding prior to enrolment; please send a soft copy of the award letter to admissions pg-ad@exeter.ac.uk.

If you defer your 2020/21 offer or change fee status then your scholarship offer will be invalidated.
