

University of Exeter Business School Future Leaders Award 2021/22

The Future Leaders Award 2021/22 of £2,000 is available to International students enrolling on a University of Exeter Business School postgraduate taught Masters programme in 2021/22, excluding Degree Apprenticeship courses and those delivered by a partner business or other institution.

The scholarship will be applied automatically to eligible postgraduate taught applicants enrolling for study beginning in the 2021/22 academic year. A separate application is not required.

This award is intended for wholly or partly self-funded students.

With the exception of any Prompt Payment Reward to which you may be eligible, you cannot receive more than one scholarship from the University of Exeter; if you are eligible for multiple scholarships you will be awarded whichever scholarship has the higher value. However, for 2021/22 a further exception has been applied to the Future Leaders Award, which can be held in conjunction with a Business School Global Excellence £5,000 or £10,000 Scholarship or MBA Scholarship¹. Business School students who are eligible for a Future Leaders Award will not receive a Global Commitment Scholarship.

If your tuition fees will be financed by an external body (such as an overseas government or Chevening, Commonwealth or a partner Institution) with whom the University has a shared financing agreement this award may be invalidated or superseded with a different fee arrangement.

If you expect to receive funding from a charity this may also make you ineligible to receive this scholarship.

It is your responsibility to inform us if you are in receipt of any external funding prior to enrolment; please send a soft copy of the award letter to admissions pg-ad@exeter.ac.uk

If you defer your 2021/22 offer or change fee status then your scholarship offer will be invalidated.

In the event that you withdraw or interrupt your studies post enrolment then the University Finance regulations at that date will apply as regards any repayment or other requirements:

This scholarship will be awarded as a reduction of the tuition fees; it cannot be paid as cash or attributed to other charges such as accommodation fees. It will be automatically deducted from your first-year tuition fees upon enrolment. If you choose to pay your tuition fees in instalments, the award will be deducted from the total annual tuition fee and the remaining balance split accordingly.

This award is not recurrent for subsequent years of study.

¹ The total value of tuition fee scholarships received in one academic year cannot exceed the annual tuition fee for that year.
