

## University of Exeter Alumni Scholarship 2024/25 and Class of 2024 Progression Scholarship

The 2024/25 Alumni and Progression Scholarships for postgraduate programmes are worth 20% of first year tuition fees for students enrolling on a standalone taught Masters degree (e.g. MA, MSc, MRes, MFA, LLM) or research degree (e.g. MPhil/PhD) in 2024/25. The PGCE programme is also eligible for this award<sup>i</sup>.

Awards are available to all home and international University of Exeter alumni and finalists who have:

- graduated from an undergraduate or postgraduate degree awarded by the University of Exeter;
- completed an inbound Study Abroad semester/year at the University of Exeter;
- completed a credit-bearing University of Exeter International Summer School.

The scholarship award will be automatically applied to eligible postgraduate applicants enrolling for study in 2024/25 (1 September 2024 – 31 August 2025). A separate scholarship application is not required.

You cannot receive more than one scholarship from the University of Exeter; if you are eligible for multiple scholarships you will be awarded whichever scholarship has the higher value. If your tuition fees will be financed by an external body (such as an overseas government or Chevening, Commonwealth or a partner Institution) with whom the University has a shared financing agreement this award may be invalidated or superseded with a different fee arrangement.

If you defer your 2024/25 offer then your scholarship offer will be invalidated.

This scholarship will be awarded as a reduction in tuition fees; it cannot be paid as cash or attributed to other charges such as accommodation fees. It will be deducted automatically from your first year tuition fees following enrolment<sup>ii</sup>. If you choose to pay your tuition fees in termly instalments, the award will be deducted from the total annual tuition fee and the remaining balance split accordingly.

This award is not recurrent for subsequent years of study.

<sup>i</sup> 1 Progression to a PGDip from a PGCert within the Clinical Education Development and Research (CEDAR) Centre is excluded from this award.

<sup>ii</sup> Tuition fees reduction/s due are applied to your student account and show in your online statement within the first four weeks of study. Any awardees studying part time will receive the full Scholarship in their first year (calculated at 20% of the full-time tuition fee).
