- In a role that supports the gathering of evidence required for the Senior People Professional apprenticeship standard.
- Evidence must be provided of Level 2 English and Maths prior to End-Point Assessment.

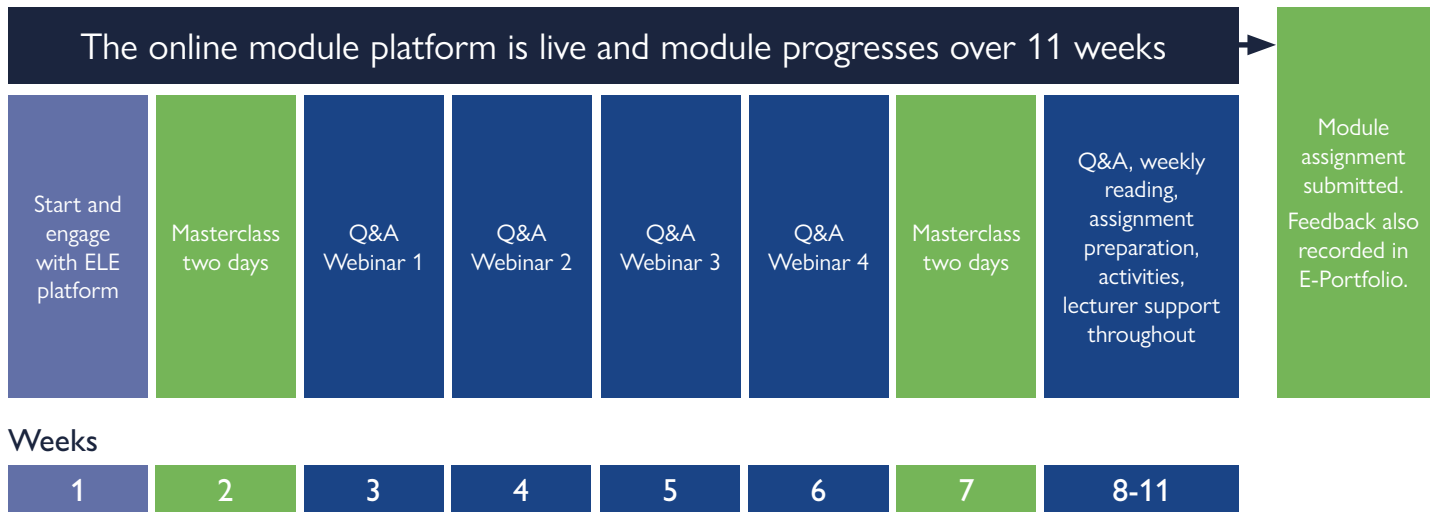
