#### Supporting Outreach

The Cornwall Opportunity Fund offers a range of options for donors who care about promoting access to higher education for young people in Cornwall, and those who want to extend Cornwall's international reach.



£5,000 – Students from less well-off backgrounds in Cornwall require extra support. Your gift of £5,000 to our 'No Talent Left Behind' scheme will help these students meet the extra costs that can be hard to find for IT equipment, travel and living expenses.



£5,000 – Studying abroad enriches the student experience immeasurably. Your gift of £5,000 will allow a student in Cornwall to take advantage of exchange agreements with prestigious global top 100 institutions including University of Leiden and University of Hong Kong, by providing a 'Cornwall Around the World' bursary to cover flights and maintenance costs.



£10,000 – Your gift of £10,000 will enable you to become a **Cornwall Opportunity**Foundation Donor. Donations to this fund will allow the University to undertake a range of employability and outreach initiatives in Cornwall.



£25,000 – Master's study is the gateway to a career in academia, but is a high bar to clear financially, especially for those whose parents are unable to fund them. Your gift of £25,000 will cover the fees and maintenance costs of a talented student looking to take the next step.



 $\pounds$ 54,000 – The Social Innovation Group are a team of researchers looking into innovative ways to empower disadvantaged communities in Cornwall though volunteering projects. Your gift of £54,000 will fund a PhD research project through the Diamond Jubilee Doctoral Scholarship scheme, opening up a whole new research strand of direct and lasting benefit to Cornish communities.



£100,000 – The University aspires to build a unique new 'Reach Out Lab' - a purpose built space on campus, open to school groups from around the county, to inspire them with the possibilities of a University education. A new build space, such as this, would be an ambitious undertaking. Your gift of £100,000 or more will kick start this initiative by providing crucial seed funding.

#### Supporting Employability

In a competitive labour market, graduates who have a range of skills and experiences have a better chance of securing a good job. Donors may wish to help students to make the best start in their working lives through one of the following options:

- Travel and maintenance bursaries for students with the opportunity to take up work placements at home and abroad.
- Degree Apprenticeships, which will give local young people a debt free opportunity to retrain and develop their careers through higher education.

#### Tax Efficient Giving

This table outlines how Gift Aid can greatly increase the total donation that the University receives. Higher rate tax payers donating via the Gift Aid scheme can claim back the difference between the higher rate of tax and the basic rate of tax on the total value of their donation via their self-assessment tax return.
