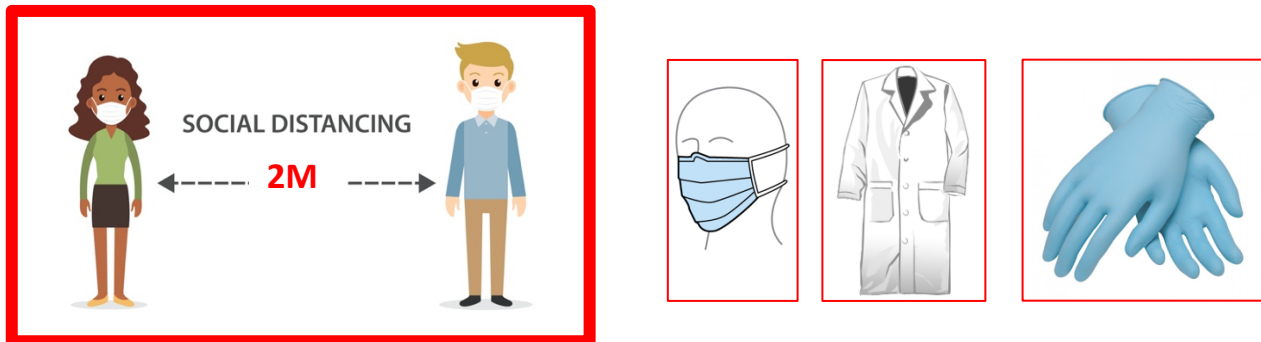


Cytometry Safety Short Guide



General Guides

- Everyone must remain 2m apart.
- Mandatory wearing of Face covering.
- Only **ONE** person/instrument is allowed in each lab.
- Gloves must be worn when operating instrumentation.
- Do not wait in the hallway for the instrument.
- All appointments must be scheduled in advance in Clustermarket-Bookit.
- If Possible: communications with core staff through email, Phone, Team or Zoom.
- If Needed: Cyto staff will join by using PPE (gloves, mask, lab coats) for troubleshooting.
- Training: Cyto staff will provide individual training by using PPE and remote control system (such wireless mouse or laser pointer)

Analyzer

- All analysers in BC01 and BC04 are the responsibility of the staff to turn on and QC
- In case of out-of hours or absence of staff: analysers are the responsibility of the users to turn on and turnoff
- Wash hands and use a new pair of gloves before using the instrument.
- Bring your own permanent marker and pen.
- Whenever an appointment is completed, spray pipettes and all surfaces down with 70% EtOH, including workstation, table and chair.
- Call 07835830710 for urgent help such as instrument troubleshooting.

Sorting

- Zoom meetings will be scheduled for discussing experiment setup
- A template will be provided to include comprehensive sorting details, including samples details and a gating strategy for experiments. Include this alongside the samples and email a copy in advance to r.yuceel@exeter.ac.uk and cytometry@exeter.ac.uk
- Leave contact information (phone & email) when dropping off samples.
- Make sure to be available for questions during the whole sorting process.
