

How to add a 1-week extension on eBART

Student Guidance

Summary and key information

If you are experiencing a short-term illness or circumstance, you now have the opportunity to add a 1-week extension to any eligible assessment. You do not need to provide evidence or contact your hub, you can simply add the extension yourself in your eBART home screen. This is a type of mitigation called ***self-certification***.

- You will have an allowance of four 1-week extensions per year.
- If you have a longer term mitigating circumstance and require more than 1 week, you should apply via the [standard mitigation route](#) and provide evidence of your circumstances.
- If you add a week's extension and ***then*** require more time, you should apply via the [standard mitigation route](#) and provide evidence of your circumstances.
- Self-certified extensions are only available on assignments, and NOT on exams. Extensions for group work must always go to the [standard mitigation route](#).

How to add a 1-week extension to a deadline

STEP 1

Log into eBART and view your home screen. You will see that some of your assignments have an 'add extension' button in the left hand column.

The 'add extension' button will not appear if:

- The deadline is more than 1 month in the future
- The deadline passed more than 24 hours ago
- The assessment is an exam, mid-term exam or group work

STEP 2

Click on 'add extension' for the assignment you'd like to extend, and you will see this screen. **Check that you are extending the correct piece of work.**

eBART will automatically calculate when your work should be extended until (one calendar week). You should then use the drop-down menu to select your reason.

Click submit to confirm.

You will be asked if you are sure – **once the extension is added you will not be able to remove it yourself.**

- Original deadline

- Remaining self-certifications
- Refresh date (the date your extension will be renewed next year)
