About Exeter Arena

Exeter Arena is the largest athletics stadium in the South West and is used by the University's Athletic Union as a training venue. The facilities include an eight-lane 400-metre synthetic track with a 10-lane straight track, and a full complement of facilities and equipment to cater for track and field athletics. Please feel free to make use of the toilet facilities and vending area on arrival. If you wish to view training facilities, Exeter Arena staff will be happy to give you a tour.




