



Assessment for Specific Learning Difficulties

If you have been advised to book an assessment for a specific learning difficulty, such as dyslexia, you can choose to book the assessment with an educational psychologist or specialist teacher.

Specialist teachers should have a Postgraduate Diploma in Specific Learning Difficulties and an assessment Practising Certificate. Educational psychologists should have current HCPC registration.

The cost of assessment will generally be from £350 to £600, but can sometimes be below or above this. To explore the possibility of reimbursement towards the cost, please see the link to the Hardship & Retention Fund:
