Postgraduate Diploma in Strategic Leadership and Management and optional Exeter MBA Top-Up

Programme cost: £14,000 (additional cost for MBA Top-Up)

Duration: 18 months (including EPA)

Our Senior Leader Apprenticeship is designed for aspiring leaders who already hold senior management roles in public or private sector organisations of all sizes. Successful graduates of the programme will have positive impact in their organisations. They will lead change in an inclusive and strategic way, will have clear focus on achieving the diverse goals of the organisation, and be capable of influencing at board or equivalent level. Externally they will act as ambassadors for their organisation, building networks and relationships with clients, suppliers and statutory bodies.

Undertaking the optional MBA Top-Up will give participants the opportunity to immerse themselves in a range of critical topics addressed in the research activities of the University of Exeter Business School and driven by its focus on responsible leadership, sustainable management and the digital economy.

Entry requirements

- A second-class honours degree, or equivalent, and at least three years' experience at a professional managerial level.
- Alternatively, a minimum of five years' management experience would be considered if no prior degree is held.
- If you have a previous qualification at a similar level in the same subject area, you may not be eligible for funding. Please contact the degree apprenticeship team to discuss prior experience and qualifications before requesting an application.
- In a role that supports the gathering of evidence required for the Senior Leader Apprenticeship standard.
- Evidence must be provided of Level 2 English and Maths prior to End Point Assessment.

Exeter MBA Top-Up

Senior Leader Apprentices have the option to top up their learning, by undertaking two optional modules, to achieve the Exeter MBA for an additional cost (individual or employer funded).

MBA Top-Up modules will be delivered entirely online. Individuals are required to sign up to complete the MBA Top-Up at the apprenticeship application stage.

- Sustainable Finance
- Influential Leader
- Corporate Storytelling
- Environmental Economics

Eligibility: The MBA Top-Up is only available to students who have successfully completed our Senior Leader Apprenticeship (Postgraduate Diploma in Strategic Leadership and Management).

Apprentices can undertake the two optional MBA Top-Up modules within a further six months minimum (subject to module availability and selection).
