- In a role that supports the gathering of evidence required for the Senior People Professional Apprenticeship standard, for example the opportunity to lead projects, access to influence strategy and implement changes.
- Evidence must be provided of Level 2 English and maths prior to End-Point Assessment.

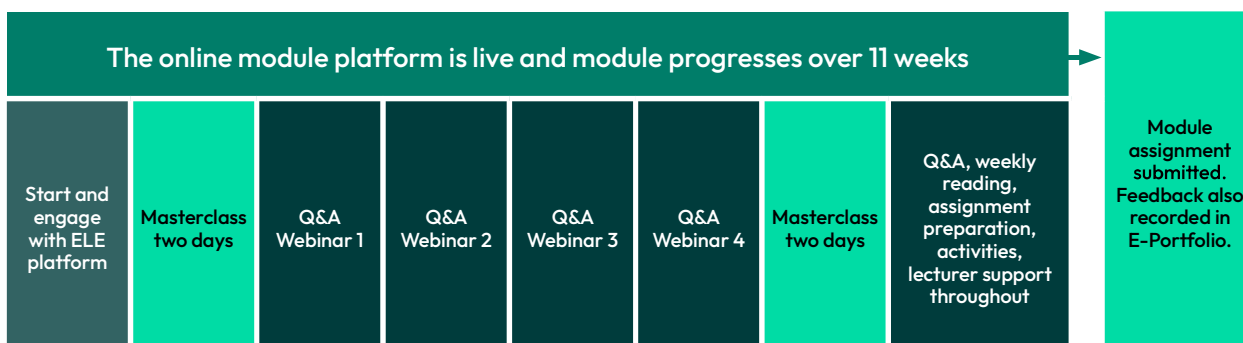
