## Level 6 Project Manager (Integrated Degree)

### BSc (Hons) Project Management

**Programme Cost:** £22,000.

**Duration:** 3 years.

The Project Manager Apprenticeship links learning directly to practice. It is designed to focus on the identification, analysis and resolution of immediate problems in the apprentices' world. Through problem-based and inquiry-led learning apprentices will develop as project managers.

The programme builds on the very latest research evidence and experience of project management in practice. It will enable participants to emerge with a rounded skill set encompassing all of the various facets of the project lifecycle. This apprenticeship enables current or aspiring project managers to develop their knowledge, skills and behaviours so that they can drive performance and productivity improvements in their organisation. Apprentices will have the opportunity to complete an International Project Management Association (IPMA) Level D qualification or equivalent. On successful completion apprentices will also be eligible to become a full member of the Association for Project Management (APM), the Chartered Body for the Project Profession. This integrated degree apprenticeship will be suitable for those both in project management roles wishing to gain new skills and a formal degree qualification and school leavers applying for degree apprenticeship roles.

### Entry requirements

The Project Management programme has two entry routes:

1. Application through A Levels CCC or equivalent Level 3 qualification.
2. Application through Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APEL): Applicants will be required before acceptance to the programme to demonstrate previous project management experience.

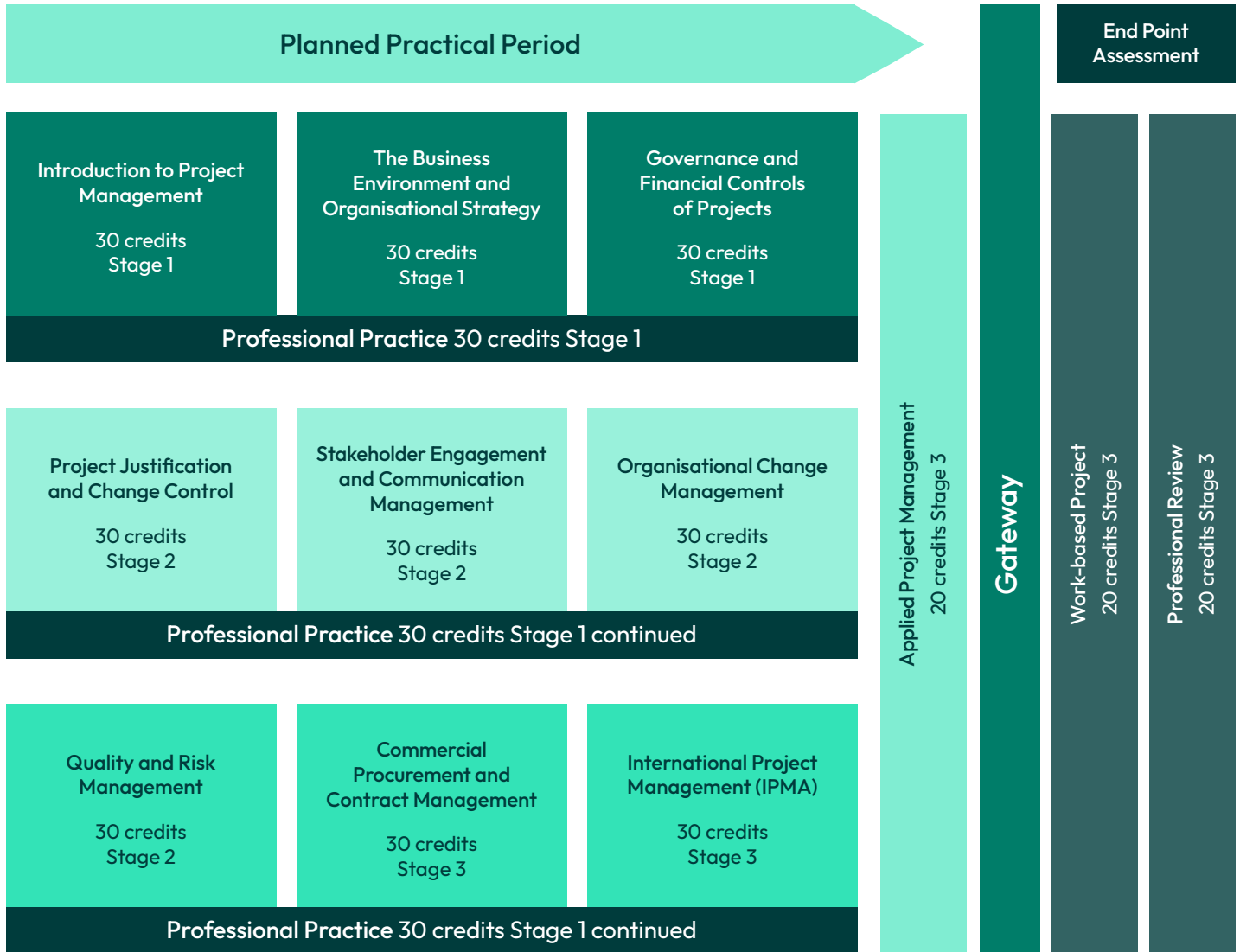
For APEL entry applicants will have a minimum of two years management experience. English and Maths will also be required at a minimum of Level 2 (GCSE) prior to the End Point Assessment.

Applicants will be in a role that supports the gathering of evidence required for the Project Management apprenticeship 'standard'.

A 2 Year Fast track option is available for Applicants who have achieved the L4 Associate Project Manager Apprenticeship, applicants can apply through accreditation of prior certificated learning (APCL). Please contact the University for further information.
