Programme cost: £22,000

Effective leadership is critical to organisational success across all sectors, and demand for skilled, qualified professionals who regularly oversee and deliver projects continues to grow. The Leadership and Project Manager Degree Apprenticeship at the University of Exeter is designed to develop confident, capable managers who are ready to deliver complex projects and drive organisational change.

The programme integrates academic study with practical, work-based learning, enabling apprentices to apply theory directly to real projects and organisational challenges. Teaching is delivered by University of Exeter academics through a structured approach that supports high-quality learning alongside day-to-day professional practice.

Duration: 3 years including EPA

Throughout the programme, apprentices develop the knowledge, skills and experience to:

- Plan, manage and deliver projects to agreed scope, time, cost and quality requirements
- Identify, assess and manage risk, change and uncertainty
- Engage, influence and manage stakeholders effectively
- Apply commercial, financial and procurement principles
- Collaborate across teams to support organisational improvement and strategic objectives.
