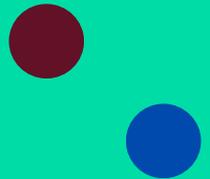
BRC PPI Group

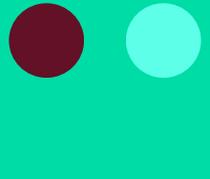
**Young People's

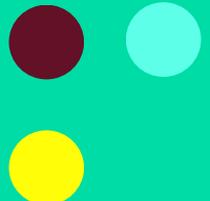
