# Our guarantee

## New postgraduate students

If you apply by 31 July 2026 we guarantee to offer you a bed space if you are:

- An unaccompanied international postgraduate entering into year one as a full-time student, who has firmly accepted the offer of a place at the University of Exeter for the full academic year starting in September.
- An unaccompanied incoming study abroad or exchange student at the University of Exeter studying for the full academic year starting in September.

Please note that it is not always possible to allocate one of your preferences. Some of our residences, particularly those located on Streatham campus, receive more applications than we have rooms to offer. If this happens, we'll use the answers in your accommodation application to guide us in finding an alternative residence. But if you meet our guarantee then you can be assured we will offer you a bedspace in one of our university or approved partner residences in the city.

If your course starts at any other time than September you can still contact us as we may be able to offer you accommodation (subject to availability at the time).

## Accommodation contract

All students living in our residences benefit from a range of additional support services\*, such as:

- Campus-based security team
- Experienced welfare support team
- Cleaning and maintenance service
- Chargeable laundry facilities
- Secure cycle storage
- Personal contents insurance

Once we have processed your application for accommodation we will send you an offer, subject to availability. If you accept the offer it will become a legally binding agreement and you will be expected to make the payments in full whether you live in accommodation arranged through the University, or in alternative private accommodation you've arranged.

\*Services offered may vary in our approved partner accommodation.

## Additional residences

Depending on the volume of applications we receive, it may be necessary for us to source additional accommodation, which may not previously have been advertised. # Developments on campus

The University of Exeter continually invests in its properties to provide new facilities and upgrade existing ones.

Work is carefully programmed to avoid disruption to students, particularly during exam periods. However, on occasion there may be some unavoidable disturbance or inconvenience to students. We will notify you in advance of any significant building works which are in close proximity to your residence and further details will be made available on our website.

## Works planned and ongoing for 2026/27

### West Park student residences

We are building our new West Park student residences on the Streatham campus in the Clydesdale area between Holland Hall (62) and Birks Grange Village (66). Holland Hall (62), Mardon Hall (58) and Nash Grove E-F blocks (57) are in close proximity to the construction area.

We expect students to move in to Phase One of the new accommodation by September 2027, and Phase Two by September 2028.

### Birks Grange Village

We are refurbishing Birks Grange catered accommodation (66) to create self-catered bedrooms and construct a new student residence block where the previous dining block was located. Birks Grange Village self-catered accommodation blocks (66) are in close proximity to the construction area. We expect students to move into the new accommodation by September 2027.

### Al Qasimi building

A new research and teaching building is proposed to extend from the Institute of Arab and Islamic Studies (IAIS) into the Jubilee Gardens. This development is in close proximity to Mardon Hall and Holland Hall and is proposed to start from summer 2026 (subject to change).

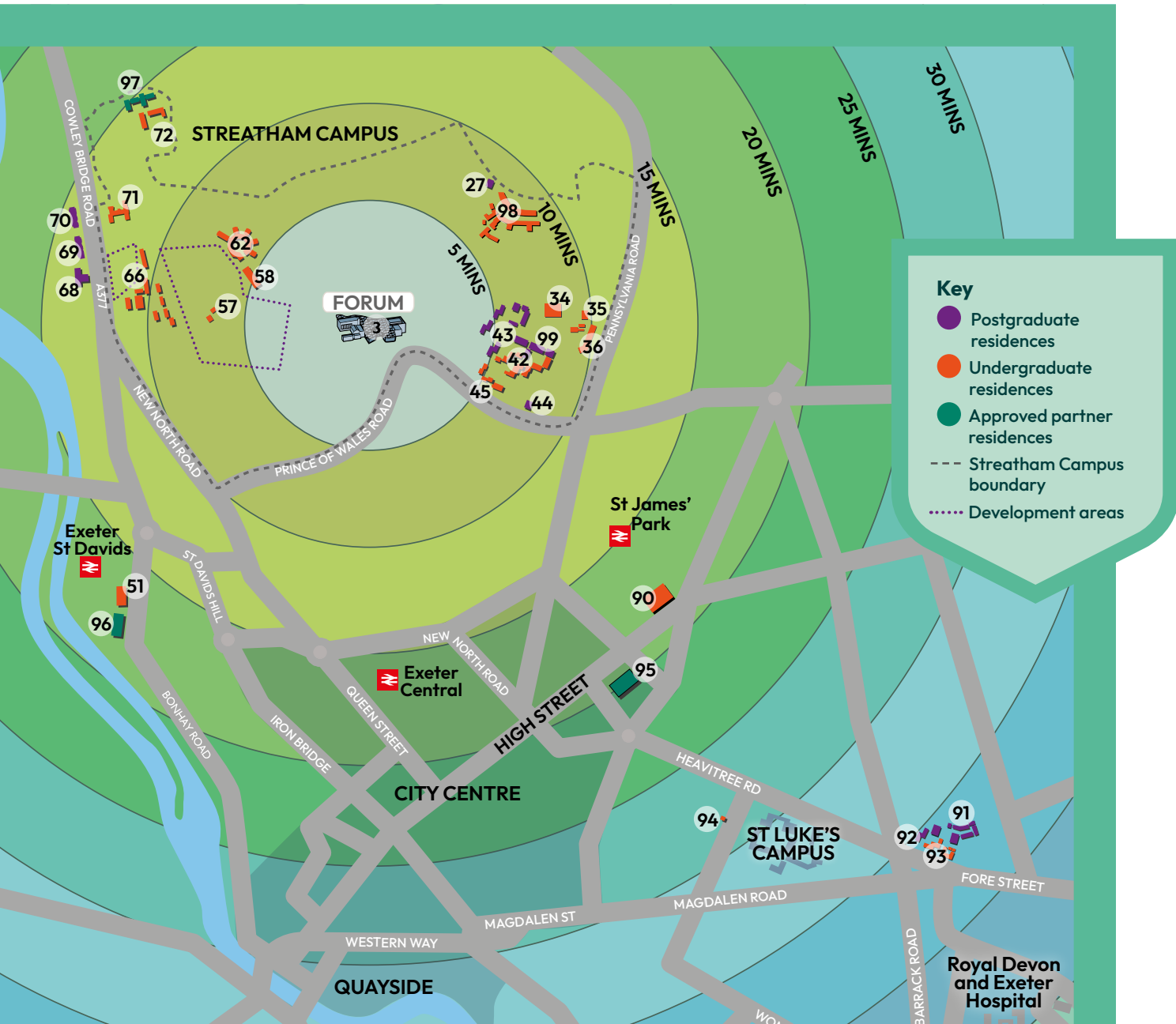
