

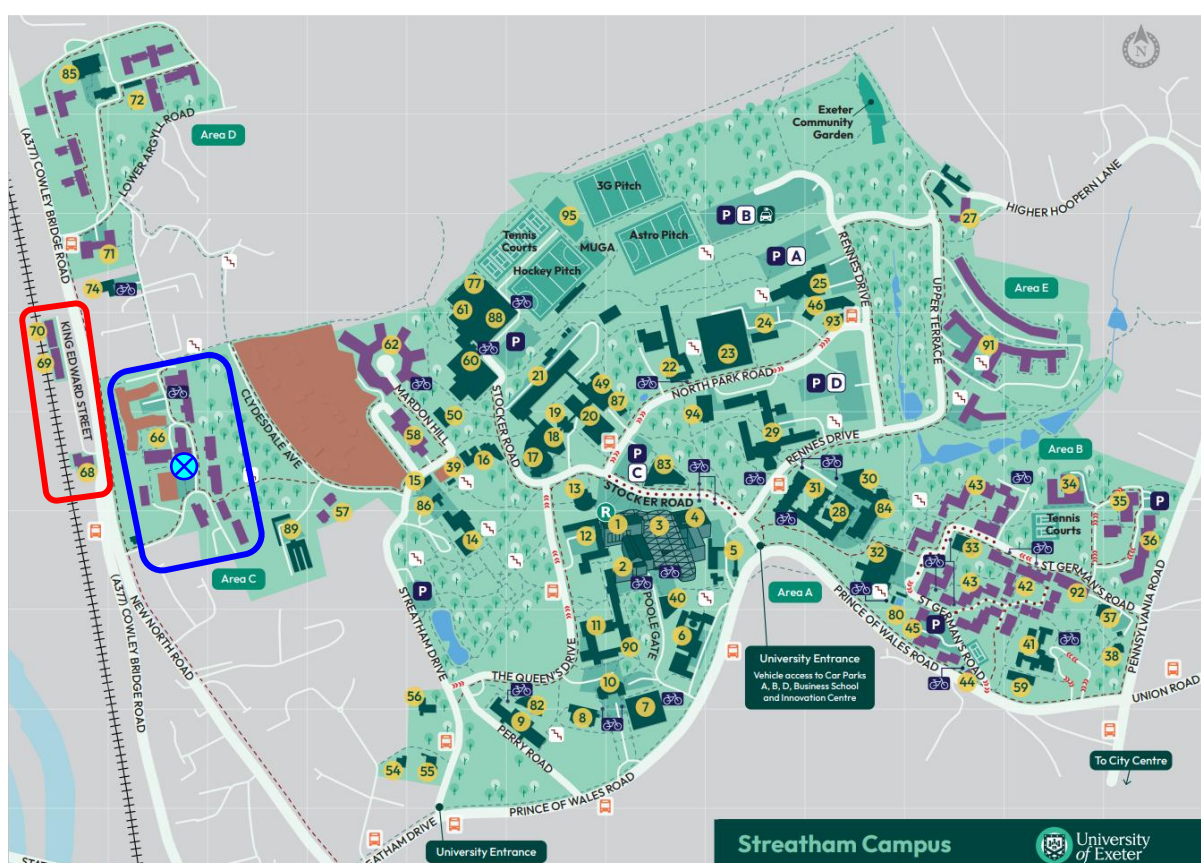
Your arrival to accommodation at Cook / Llewellyn Mews and King Edward Court

This information is relevant to students arriving on **Saturday 12 or Sunday 13 September between 09:00-23:30 ONLY.**

If you will be arriving after Welcome Weekend, please return to the [previous webpage](#) and refer to the information about 'Arriving outside of reception opening hours'.

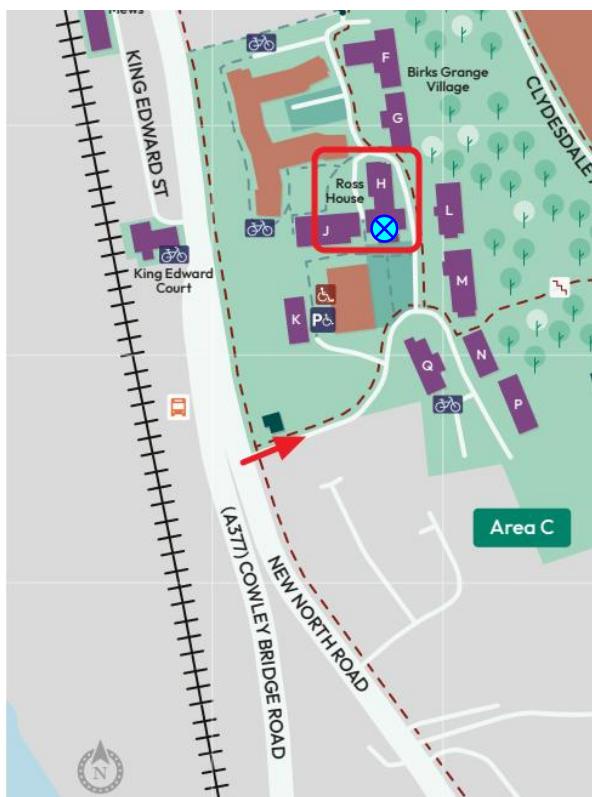
Welcome to Exeter! We hope this information helps you understand what to expect when you arrive at your accommodation.

This is a map of Streatham Campus – available [here](#) – and we've shown the location of King Edward Court (#68), Cook Mews (#69) and Llewellyn Mews (#70) with a red border:



If you are arriving between 09:00-23:30 on Saturday 12 or Sunday 13 September, then you will need to go to Ross House reception at **Birks Grange Village** (#66) to collect your key. This is shown with a blue border on the above map, with reception indicated by a blue crossed dot.

Key collection at Birks Grange Village – 09:00-23:30 on Saturday 12 or Sunday 13 September



The entrance to Birks Grange Village is from New North Road, where it meets the A377 Cowley Bridge Road.

If you are travelling along Cowley Bridge Road from the city, you will not be able to turn right onto New North Road. Instead, continue a bit further along until you can safely make a U-turn.

The key collection point is the reception at Ross House, Birks Grange Village H block, New North Road, EX4 4GE. It's shown here by a blue crossed dot.

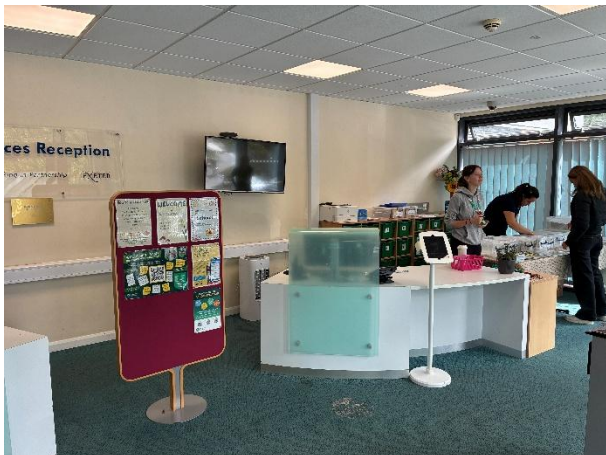
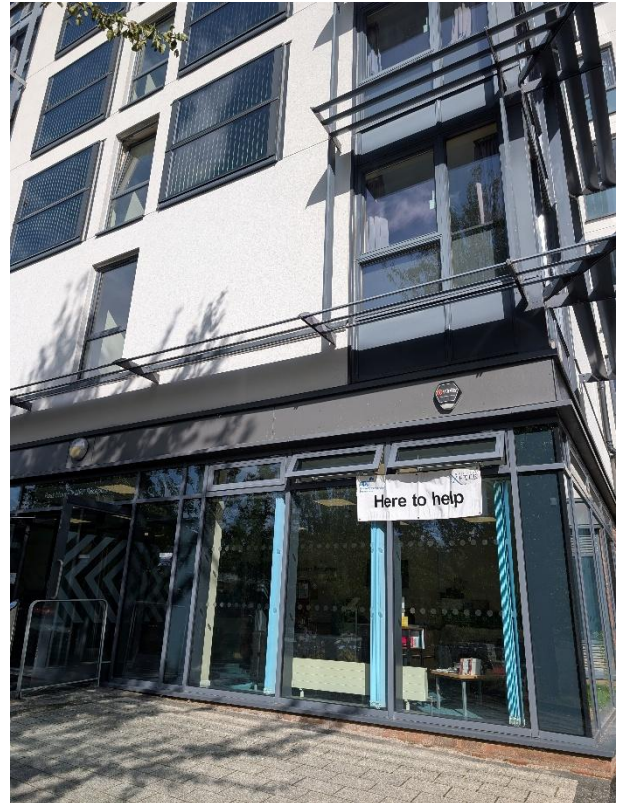
This is the entrance to Birks Grange Village from New North Road.

As you continue up the road, depending on your arrival time, there may be parking attendants to meet you; they should be wearing hi-vis jackets. They will advise you about temporarily parking your car while you collect your keys at reception.

Things might look a bit different as construction work is ongoing. You might want to wear headphones or ear defenders if you are sensitive to noise as you move around this area.



This is Ross House, the reception at Birks Grange Village.



Inside the key collection point there will be staff to meet you. They will need to see your photo ID so that they can give you your key/fob and other helpful information.

You can then return to your car and head to your residence (postcode EX4 4NY), which is 1-2 minutes' drive/6 minutes' walk away.

Top tip! If you are arriving by taxi, ask the driver to wait while you collect your key at Birks Grange Village, so that they can take you on to your residence afterwards.

Have fun unpacking and making your room your home!

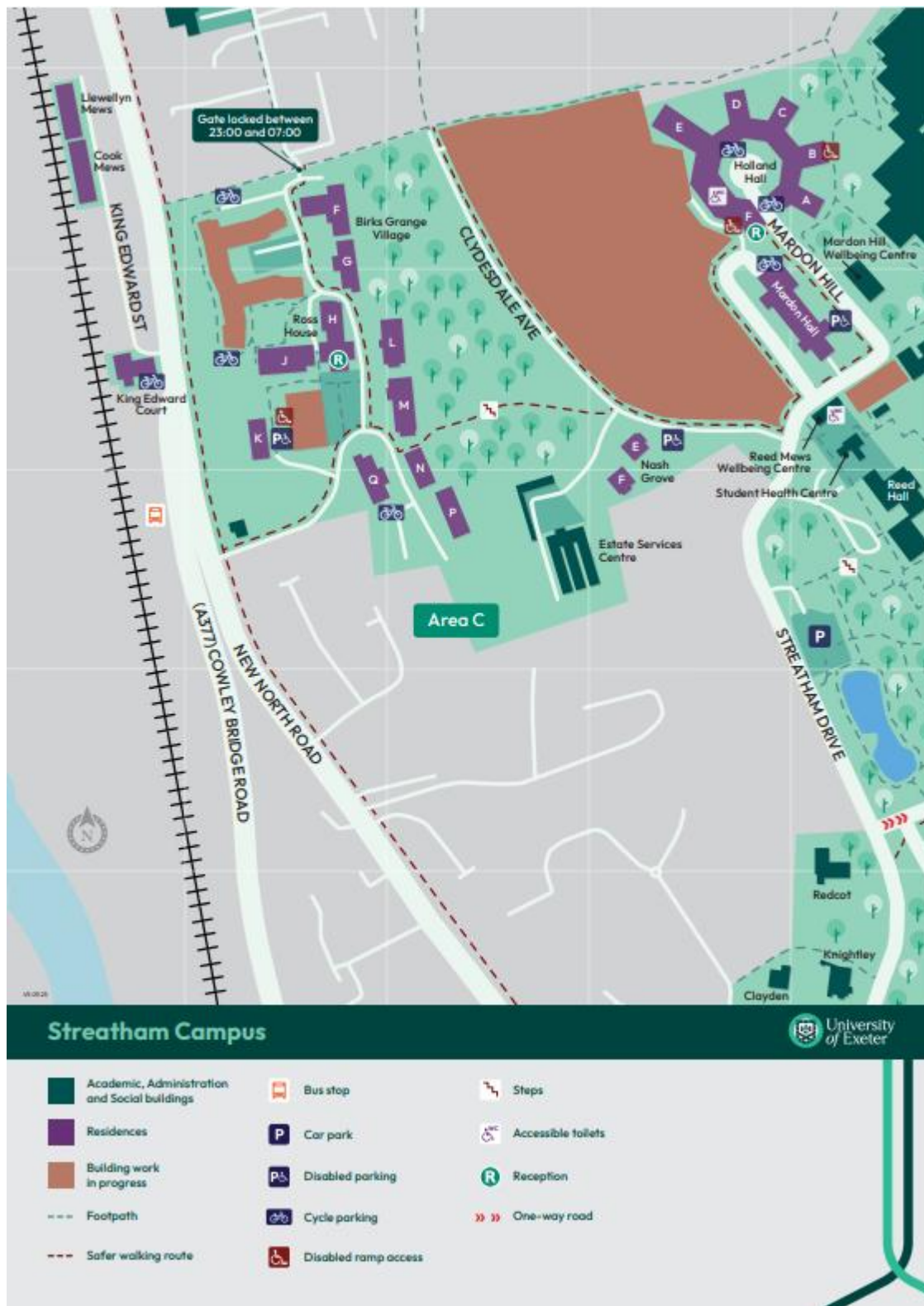


Useful to know! After Welcome Weekend, your main reception will be at Holland Hall (marked on the above map in blue). If you need to get to Holland Hall reception on foot, it is approximately 15 minutes' walk **uphill** from Cook/Llewellyn Mews or King Edward Court. Once you reach Mardon Hall, follow the path in front of Mardon and you will find an entrance to F block as shown in the photos above. Reception is located one floor up and can be accessed either by stairs in this entranceway, or go through the double doors to get to the lift.

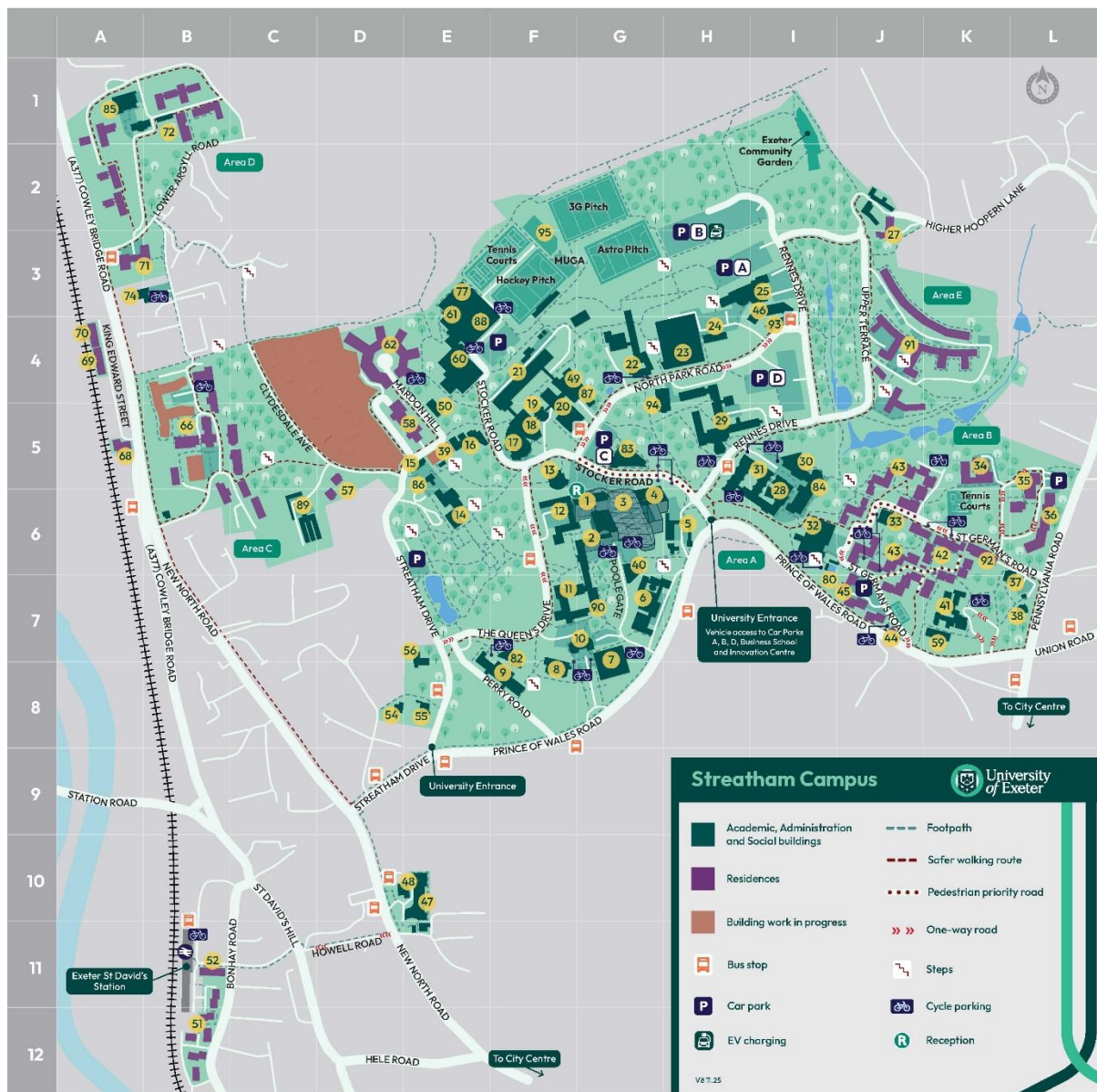
- Your main reception is at Holland Hall, Clydesdale Road, Exeter, EX4 4SA. Reception opening times, email address and telephone number are available here: <https://www.exeter.ac.uk/study/accommodation/current-residents/residence-receptions/> [N.B. Ross House reception is for key collection over Welcome Weekend only].
- There is construction work ongoing at Birks Grange Village. You may want to wear headphones or ear defenders if you are going through the area and are sensitive to noise.

- Please make sure you have completed your Welcome Induction for your accommodation. You will receive an email from the Accommodation Office advising when this is available to you, and you access it by logging in to your accommodation account. It takes you through lots of important information about living in accommodation and specifics to your residence.
- Once you have completed the Welcome Induction you will be able to book your arrival slot.
- On the following pages are a full map of Streatham Campus and the Birks Grange Village area. There are several different footpaths which connect these areas to the central campus. You will also see the 'Safer Walking Route' which is marked in brown. These dedicated walkways have enhanced lighting along with coverage by the University CCTV cameras along many paths. Keep an eye out for the green floor dots and lamppost signs that mark out the routes on campus.
