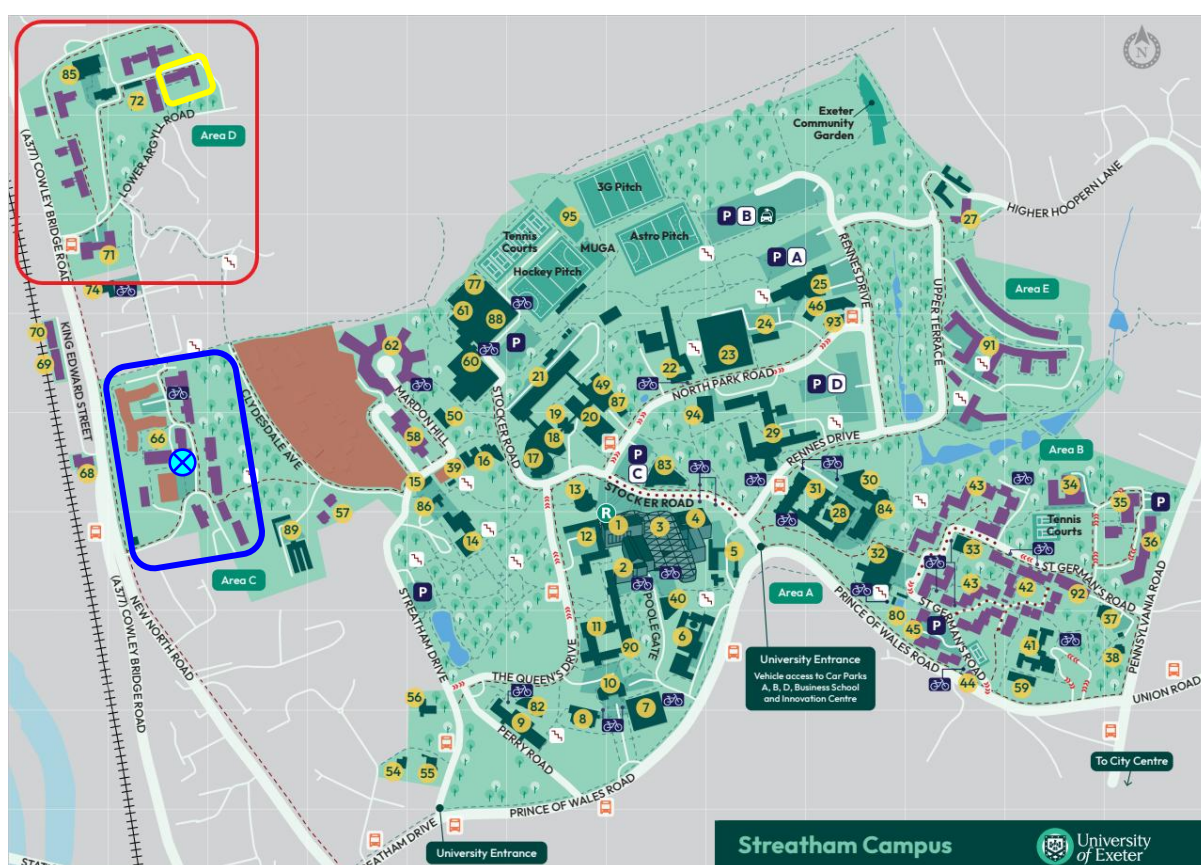


Your arrival to accommodation at Duryard: Yeo and Teign

This information is relevant to students arriving on **Friday 11, Saturday 12, or Sunday 13 September between 09:00-23:30 ONLY**. If you will be arriving after Welcome Weekend, please return to the [previous webpage](#) and refer to the information about 'Arriving outside of reception opening hours'.

Welcome to Exeter! We hope this information helps you understand what to expect when you arrive at your accommodation.

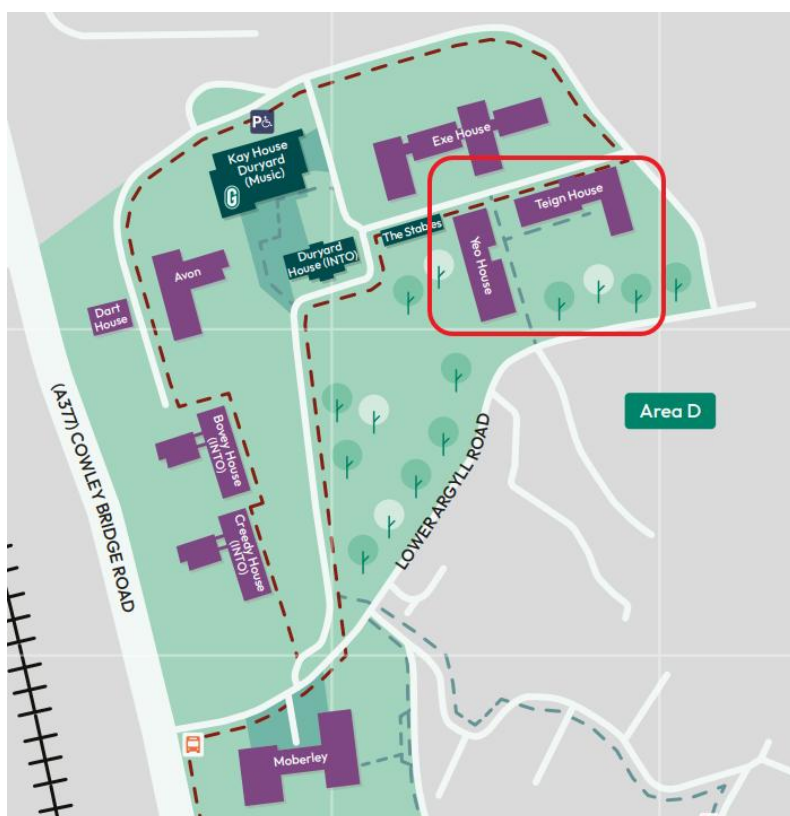
This is a map of Streatham Campus – available [here](#) – and we've shown the location of the Duryard area with a red border (Duryard #72):



If you are arriving between 09:00-16:00 on 11/12/13 September then you will need to go to Teign House, Duryard (#72) to collect your key. This is shown with a yellow border on the above map.

Between 16:30-23:30 on these days, keys will be issued from Ross House reception, Birks Grange Village (#66) so you'll need to go there instead. This is shown with a blue border on the above map, with reception indicated by a blue crossed dot. You'll find information about Birks Grange Village later in this document.

Key collection at Teign House, Duryard between 09:00-16:00



Focussing in on the Duryard area, you can see the Yeo and Teign blocks marked on this map. The full version of this map is included at the end of this document.

Some of the surrounding buildings are accommodation blocks belonging to our education partner, ISC (International Study Centre).

The postcode for Duryard is EX4 4GQ.



When you enter Lower Argyll Road from the A377 Cowley Bridge Road, you need to continue all the way up to the top of the road, then on the left-hand side you will see an entranceway with stone pillars. Turn in here.



Keep following this road down the hill, and a parking attendant will meet you at the bottom. They should be wearing a hi-vis jacket. They will ask which block you will be living in and explain where the closest place to park is for unloading your belongings.



This is the key collection point at Teign House.



You will probably be asked to park your car in the area just to the right of Teign House. You have 30 minutes to unload your car before it will need to be moved to central parking on campus.

Alternatively, you might find space on Lower Argyll Road – this is private parking which you need to pay for, so look for the machines and signage.



Inside the key collection point there will be staff to meet you. They will need to see your photo ID so that they can give you your key/fob and other helpful information.

Once you have your fob, you can start unloading your car and transferring your belongings to your room.



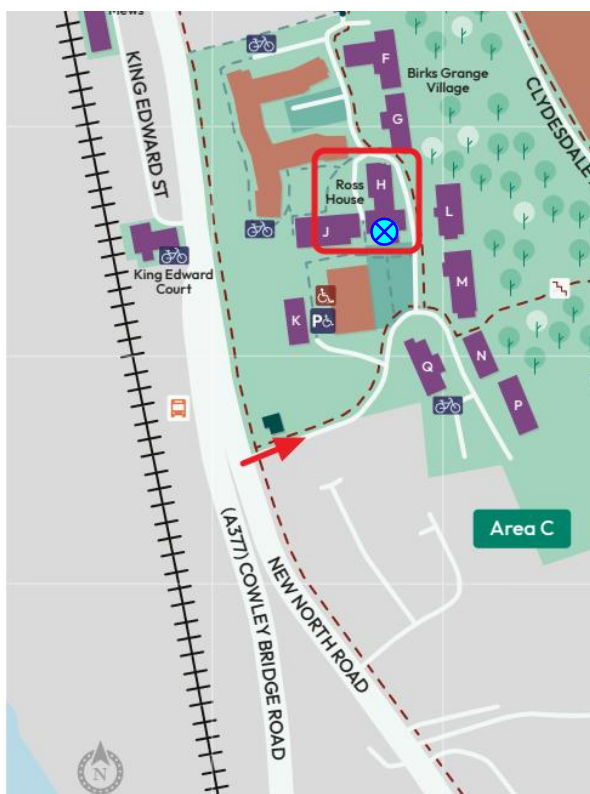
You might see Student Helpers around the residences. They will be wearing yellow jackets and can help you find your room or give you directions.



If you see a trolley like this, you can borrow it to help move your belongings to your room. Please return it once you have finished using it, so it is ready for the next person.

Key collection at Ross House reception, Birks Grange Village between 16:30-23:30



The entrance to Birks Grange Village is from New North Road, where it meets the A377 Cowley Bridge Road.

If you are travelling along Cowley Bridge Road from the city, you will not be able to turn right onto New North Road. Instead, continue a bit further along until you can safely make a U-turn.

The key collection point is the reception at Ross House, Birks Grange Village H block, New North Road, Exeter, EX4 4GE. It's shown here by a blue crossed dot.

This is the entrance to Birks Grange Village from New North Road.

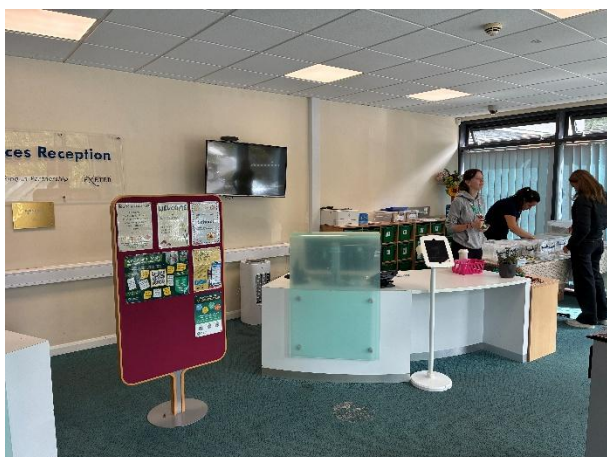
As you continue up the road, there may be parking attendants to meet you; they should be wearing hi-vis jackets. They will advise you about temporarily parking your car while you collect your keys at reception.

Things might look a bit different as construction work is ongoing. You might want to wear headphones or ear defenders if you are sensitive to noise as you move around this area.



This is Ross House, the reception at Birks Grange Village.





Inside the key collection point there will be staff to meet you. They will need to see your photo ID so that they can give you your key/fob and other helpful information.

You can then return to your car and head to Duryard (postcode EX4 4GQ), which is about 5 minutes' drive away.



When you enter Lower Argyll Road from the A377 Cowley Bridge Road, you need to continue all the way up to the top of the road, then on the left-hand side you will see an entranceway with stone pillars. Turn in here.



Keep following this road down the hill, and you'll come to a staff car park at the bottom. There may not be a parking attendant by the time you arrive, but by turning left after the car park you will be able to follow the access road to get close to your block (check the map at the end of this document to locate your block – Yeo or Teign).

Once you reach your block, you have 30 minutes to unload your belongings before you will need to move your car to central parking on campus.

Alternatively, you might find space on Lower Argyll Road – this is private parking which you need to pay for, so look for the machines and signage.

Top tip! If you are arriving by taxi, ask the driver to wait while you collect your key at Birks Grange Village, so that they can take you on to Duryard afterwards.

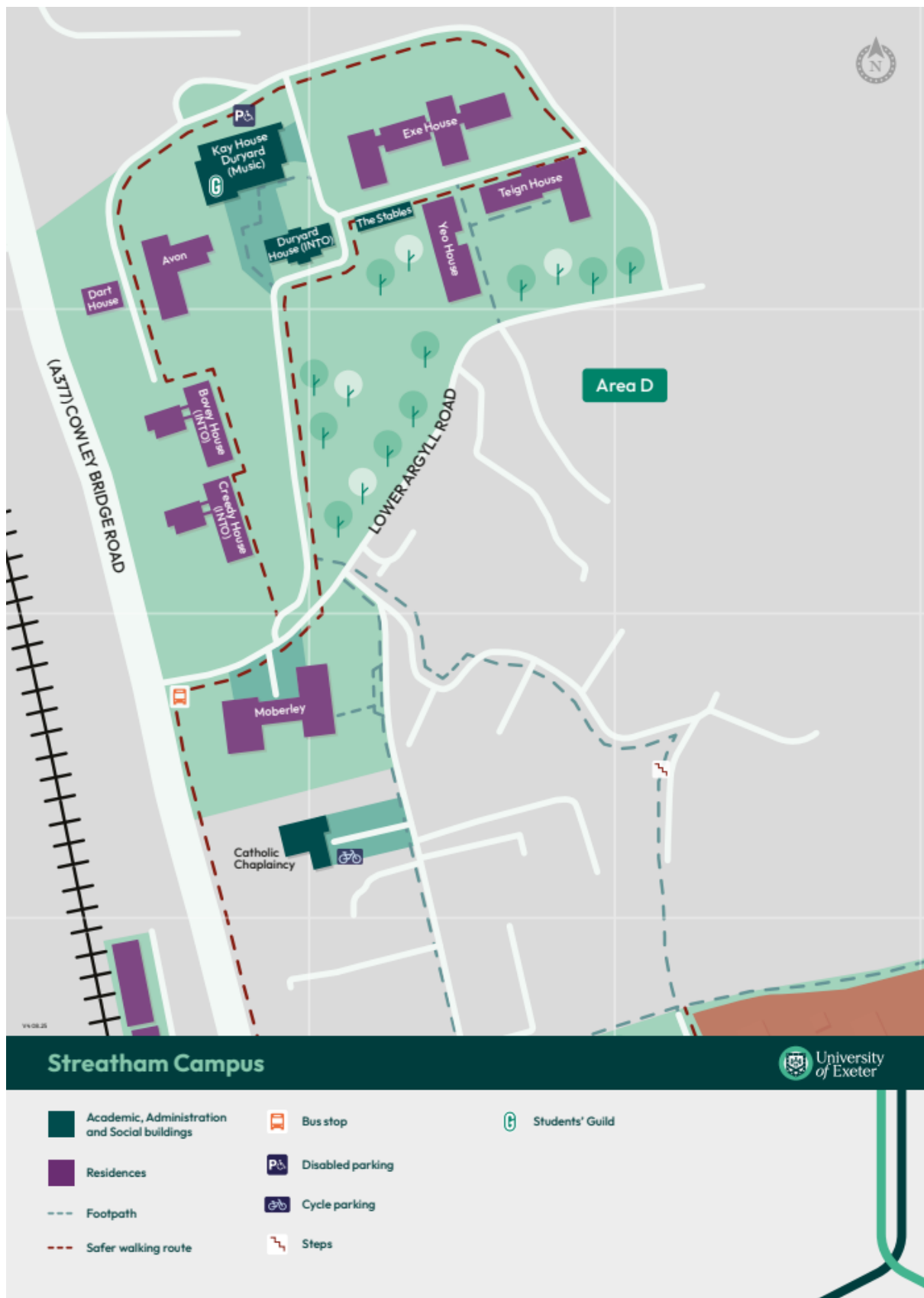
Have fun unpacking and making your room your home!

- Your main reception is at Ross House, Birks Grange Village H Block, New North Road, Exeter, EX4 4GE. Reception opening times, email address and telephone number are available here:

- It's a 10-12 minute walk between Duryard and Birks Grange Village. It is then another 15 minutes to walk from Birks Grange Village and the Forum building in the centre of campus.
- There is construction work ongoing at Birks Grange Village. You may want to wear headphones or ear defenders if you are going through the area and are sensitive to noise.

- Please make sure you have completed your Welcome Induction for your accommodation. You will receive an email from the Accommodation Office advising when this is available to you, and you access it by logging in to your accommodation account. It takes you through lots of important information about living in accommodation and specifics to your residence.
- Once you have completed the Welcome Induction you will be able to book your arrival slot.
- On the following pages are full maps of the Streatham Campus, Duryard and Birks Grange Village areas. There are several different footpaths which connect Duryard to the central campus via Birks Grange Village. You will also see the

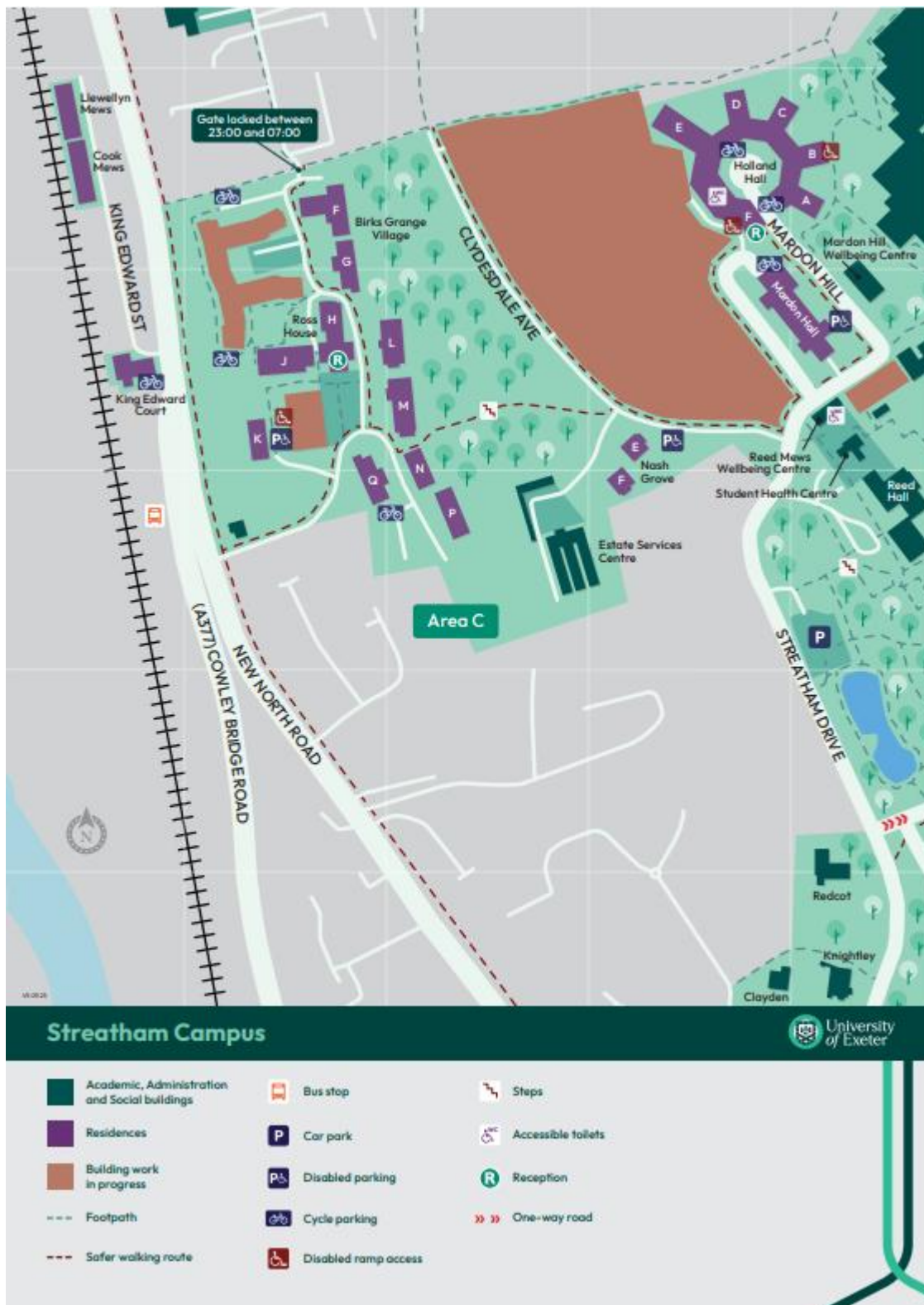

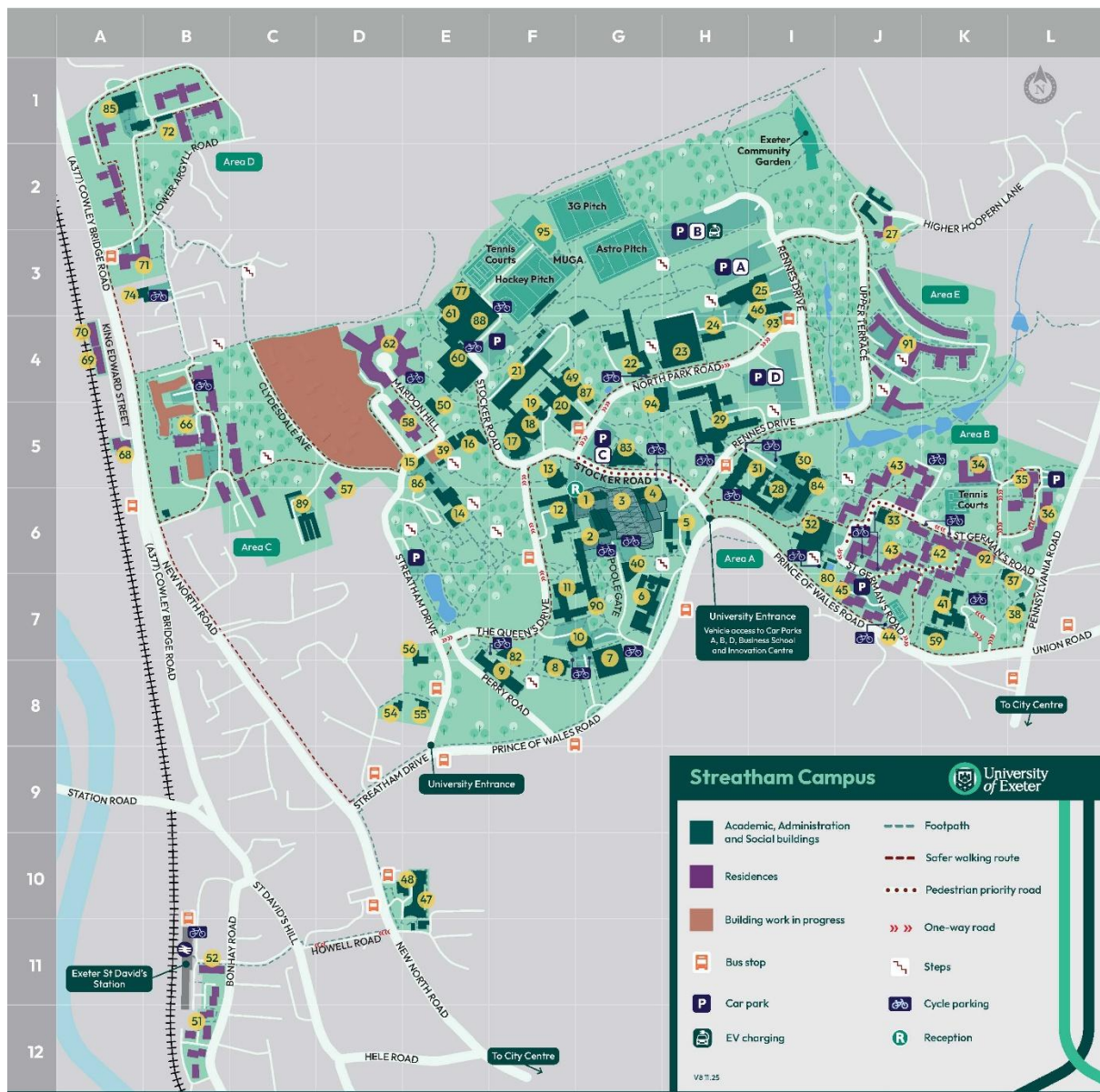
The Duryard area.
