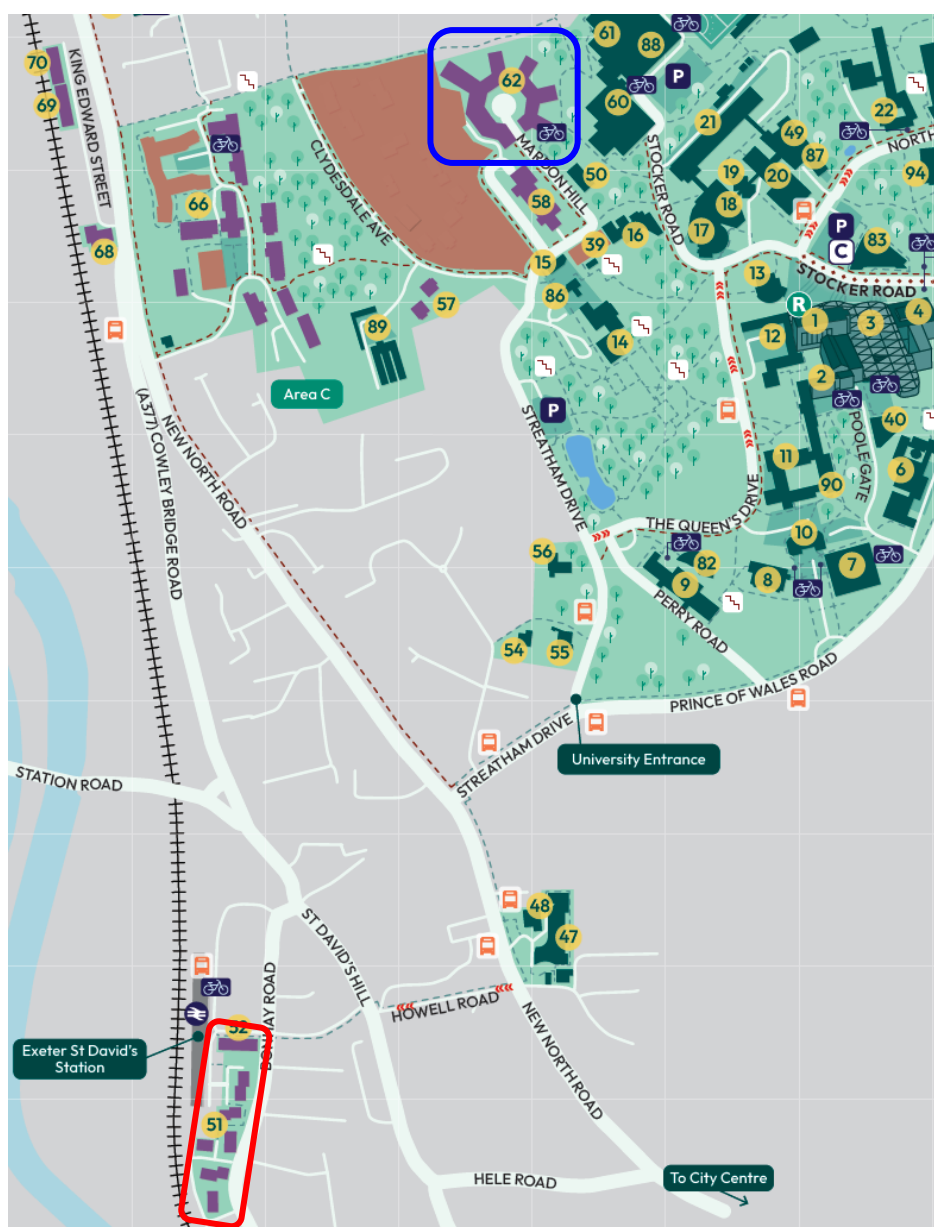


Your arrival to accommodation at St David's (Brunel Close and Kingdom Mews)

This information is relevant to students arriving on **Saturday 12 September and Sunday 13 September between 09:00-23:30 ONLY**. If you will be arriving after Welcome Weekend, please return to the [previous webpage](#) and refer to the information about 'Arriving outside of reception opening hours'.

Welcome to Exeter! We hope this information helps you understand what to expect when you arrive at your accommodation.

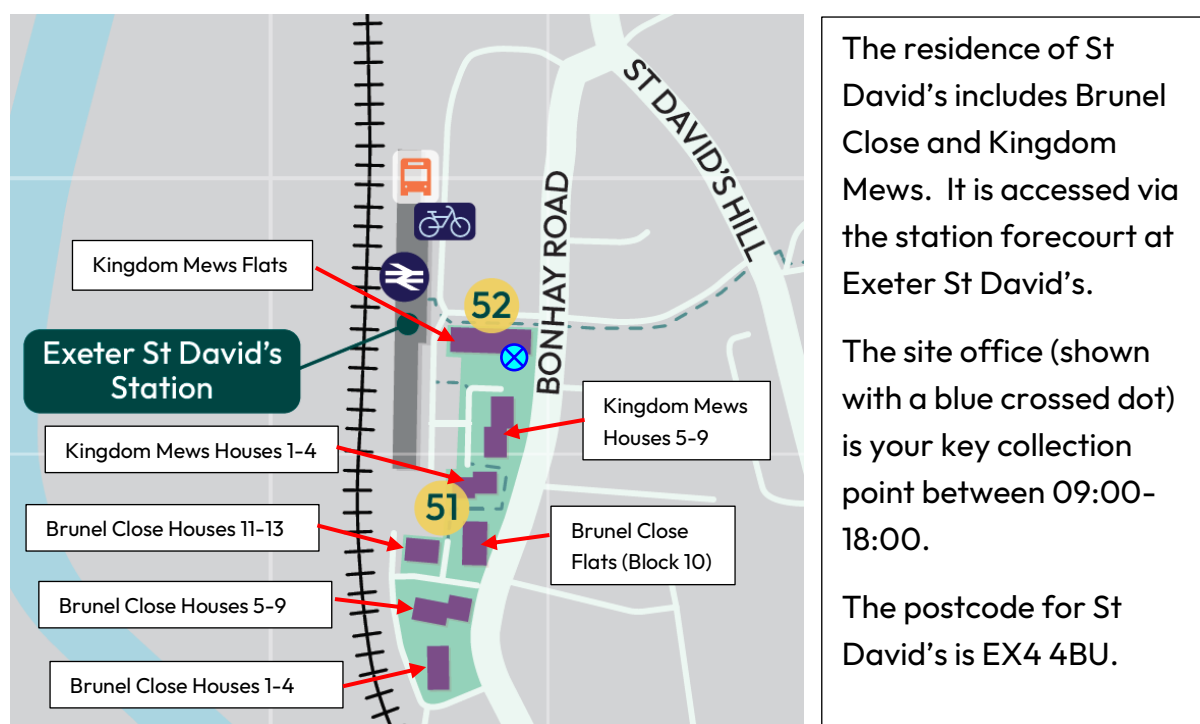
This is a map of the west side of Streatham Campus – full version available [here](#) – and we've shown the location of St David's (#51) with a red border:



If you are arriving between 09:00-18:00 on Saturday 12 or Sunday 13 September, your keys will be issued from a collection point at **St David's** (#51). This is shown with a red border.

If you are arriving between 19:00-23:30 on Saturday 12 or Sunday 13 September, then you will need to go to **Holland Hall** (#62) to collect your key. This is shown with a blue border on the above map.

Key collection at St David's – 09:00-18:00 on Saturday 12 or Sunday 13 September



From Bonhay Road, turn into Exeter St Davids station forecourt – you will have a parade of shops on your left (Isambard Parade). Immediately after the shops, turn left. Approximately 50m down you will see the turning into the St David's residence. You should see a parking attendant who will be wearing a hi-vis jacket. They will advise you about parking your car so that you can collect your key.



As you turn left from the site entrance, you will be able to see the key collection point in the far corner.



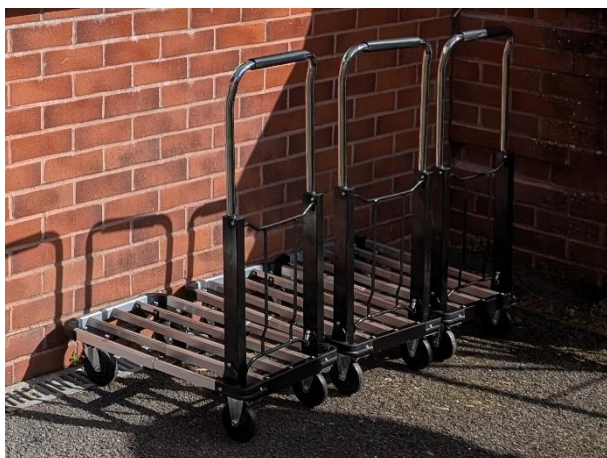
Inside the key collection point there will be staff to meet you. They will need to see your photo ID so that they can give you your key/fob and other helpful information.



You might see student helpers around the residences. They will be wearing yellow jackets and can help you find your room or answer questions.

You then have 30 minutes to unload your belongings. After this time you will need to find alternative parking in the city or on central campus.

If you are in the Brunel Close houses or flats then you can get closer to these blocks by exiting the station forecourt and turning right onto Bonhay Road, then taking the next road on your right into Brunel Close.



If you see a trolley like this, you can borrow it to help move your belongings to your room. Please return it once you have finished using it, so it is ready for the next person.

Key collection at Holland Hall – 19:00-23:30 on Saturday 12 or Sunday 13

September



Holland Hall is located on Clydesdale Road at the top of Streatham Drive.

Because of nearby construction work, vehicle access will be via Mardon Hill – this will be signposted from Streatham Drive.

The key collection point is at Holland Hall reception. Full address is Holland Hall, Clydesdale Road, Exeter, EX4 4SA.

Please note that it would be a 2km walk **uphill** (approximately 25 minutes) from St David's to Holland Hall. By car it only takes about 6 minutes.



This is the University entrance at Streatham Drive. The photo on the left is looking up from the direction of New North Road, and the photo on the right is looking down from Prince of Wales Road. Turn in here.



Head up Streatham Drive (do not take the right turn onto The Queen's Drive) and after rounding the corner towards the top of the hill follow the road around to your left (do not take the right turn into Reed Hall).

Things might look a bit different when you arrive because construction work in this area is ongoing.



Keep going up the hill. You'll pass Mardon Hall on your left-hand side but you should continue to follow the road. At the top, the road bears left onto Mardon Hill.

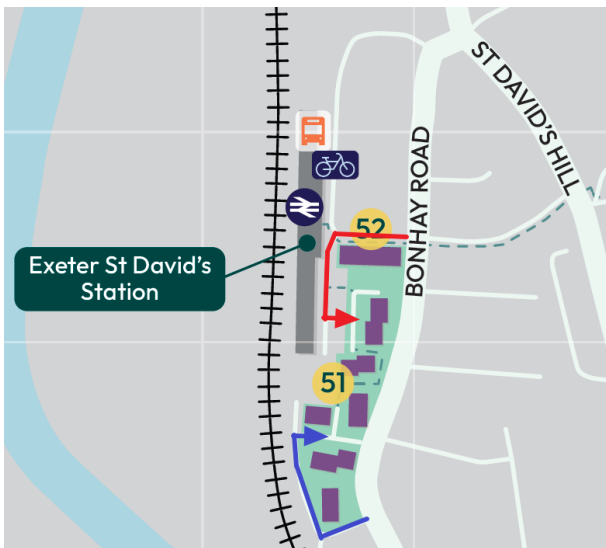


At the end of Mardon Hill you will reach an open area in between the blocks at Holland Hall. Depending on your arrival time, there may be a parking attendant who will be wearing a hi-vis jacket. You can park your car here while you collect your key and unpack your belongings, but please do not block the entrance as it is the only way in/out. As you approach from Mardon Hill, the reception is to your left, in F block.



Inside reception, staff will need to see your photo ID so that they can give you your key/fob and other helpful information.

You can then return to your car and head to St David's (postcode EX4 4BU), which is approximately 6 minutes' drive away.



At St David's you have 30 minutes to unload your car before it will need to be moved to alternative parking elsewhere.

If you are living in Kingdom Mews, the closest parking areas to these blocks can be accessed from the station forecourt entrance (red arrow). If you are living in Brunel Close, you can get closer to these blocks by taking the Brunel Close turning off Bonhay Road (blue arrow).

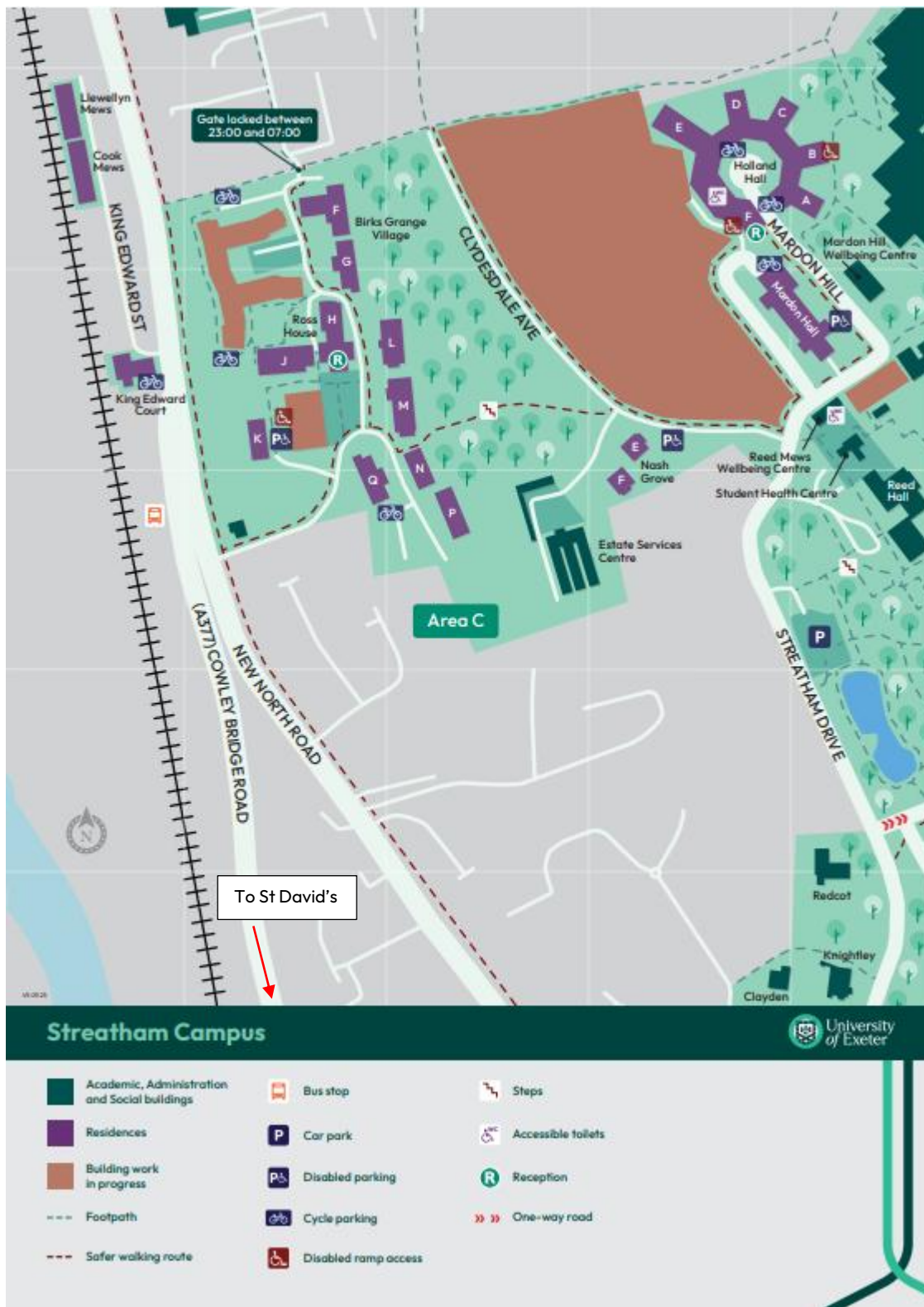
Top tip! If you are arriving by taxi, ask the driver to wait while you collect your key at Holland Hall, so that they can take you back to St David's afterwards.

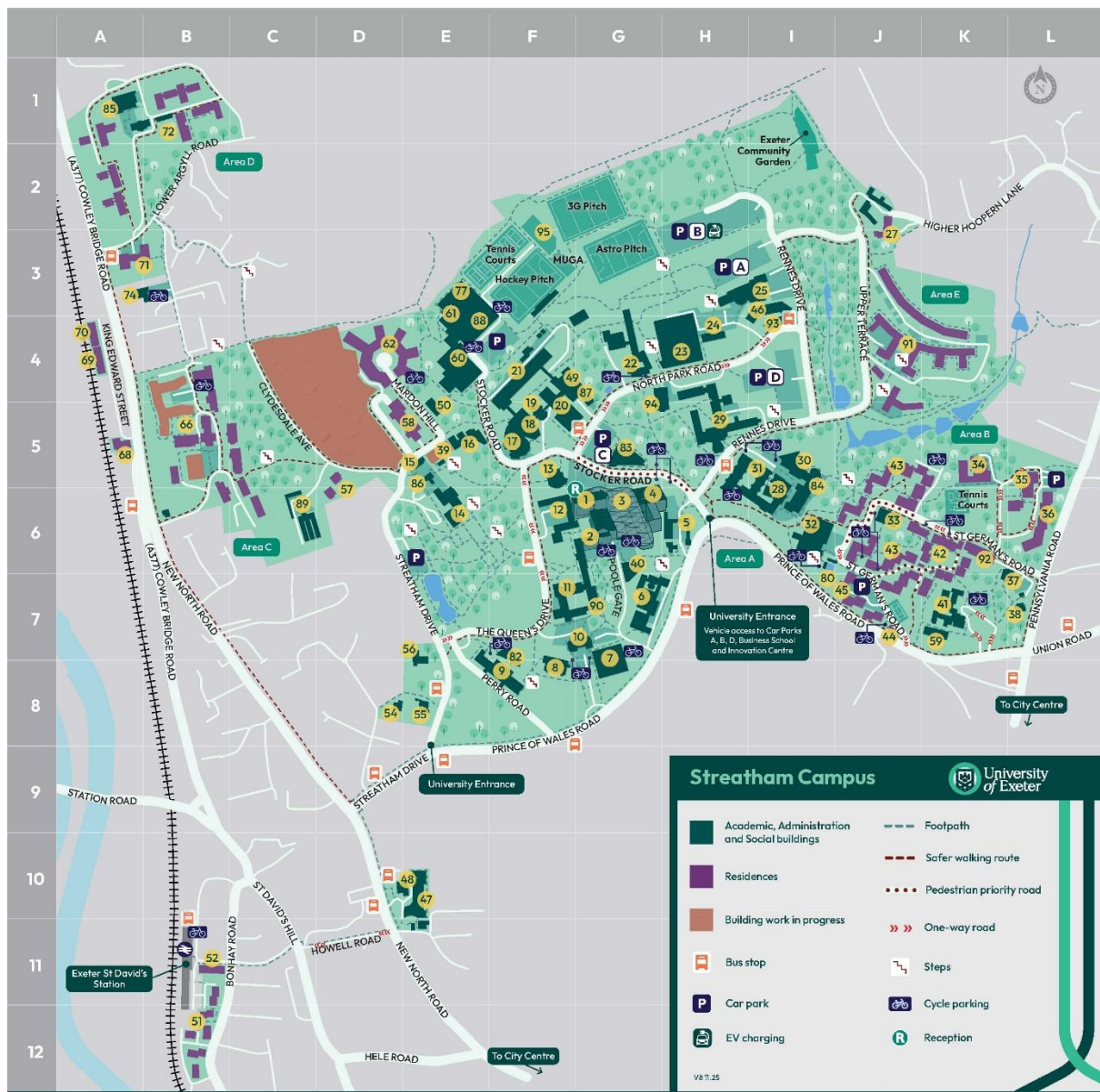

- There is construction work ongoing around the Holland Hall and Birks Grange Village areas. You may want to wear headphones or ear defenders if you are going through the area and are sensitive to noise.

- Please make sure you have completed your Welcome Induction for your accommodation. You will receive an email from the Accommodation Office advising when this is available to you, and you access it by logging in to your accommodation account. It takes you through lots of important information about living in accommodation and specifics to your residence.
- Once you have completed the Welcome Induction you will be able to book your arrival slot.
- On the following pages are a full map of Streatham Campus and the Birks Grange Village / Holland Hall areas. There are several different footpaths which connect these areas to the central campus. You will also see the 'Safer Walking Route' which is marked in brown. These dedicated walkways have enhanced lighting along with coverage by the University CCTV cameras along many paths. Keep an eye out for the green floor dots and lamppost signs that mark out the routes on campus.
