

# FCH MODULE CHOICE GUIDE

Time to choose your modules for next academic year! This guide has a page for every subject. You **MUST** read this page for **ESSENTIAL** instructions then click your subjects from the contents page. There is also a 5 minute [video guide from Marion you MUST watch](#).

1. **Module Choice opens 9am GMT Monday 15th March 2021 and closes 5pm Friday 26th March 2021.** You **MUST** submit your choices before the deadline: if missed, choices will be limited, modules may be selected for you.
2. **Before final submission you MUST write in the comments box** how many credits of each subject you wish to take; otherwise departments will not know how many credits to allocate you.
3. **You MUST choose at least 120 credits (full-time).** For some subjects this will be more because you will have to rank a list of options. **Failure to rank modules where required** will likely result in modules being selected at departmental discretion.
4. **All students must choose at least 30 credits for each of their subjects.** Those studying three subjects, please discuss with Marion, Damien, or Tim if you plan to make changes, such as drop a subject for next year.
5. **All FINALISTS must choose at least 120 credits of modules with codes beginning 3.** The only exceptions are those continuing a language started in year 2, or needing to complete core modules from stage 2. If you wish to take a level 2 option in final year you will wait until September and must get permission from the FCH Director.
6. **You must select your own compulsory (core) modules as part of your selections.** Your compulsory modules are shown on the FCH website in current students (there are links on each subject page in this document).
7. **Students on a 4 year programme taking a study / work placement next year are advised to access online module selection to choose final year modules just in case your placement does not go ahead. The placement year module will be added to your record by Tim having consulted with Outbound.**
8. Taking up a new subject in final year is not possible. Taking a level 1 module in final year is not possible.
9. **Please consult Marion, Damien or Tim if:**
  - A. You are considering changing the balance of credits between your subjects.
  - B. You are considering changing one of your subjects going into year 2
  - C. You are considering taking more than 60 credits of modules in a single term
  - D. You are considering taking an independent study instead of a dissertation
  - E. You will be studying part-time next year.

Some languages do not currently go up to Advanced level e.g. Japanese, Korean, and British Sign Language.

Fast track Beginners would be followed by Fast track Intermediate, which would then be followed by Advanced 1.

If you wish to take 2 option modules you submit 4 numbered 1-4. **Don't forget to state how many GEO credits you require in the Comments box before making your final submission.**

**Please remember to put how many credits of each subject you wish to take in the Comments Box before final submission of modules.**

Those of you doing Sustainability can refer to the PDF of modules made available, which lists possible modules relevant to Sustainability from a selection of disciplines.

**ALL SUSTAINABILITY STUDENTS PLEASE NOTE** – If you are doing another subject that has Sustainability options, you cannot use it to take most of your modules in that subject e.g. if you are taking Management and Sustainability, you cannot take most of your Sustainability options from Management – it would essentially create the equivalent of a single honours degree. The point of a themed pathway is to mix up your modules, and take them from a variety of disciplines.

There is also a limit to how many subjects can be made available for online module choice. 4 is the max. So not all possible subjects can be viewed for Sustainability.
