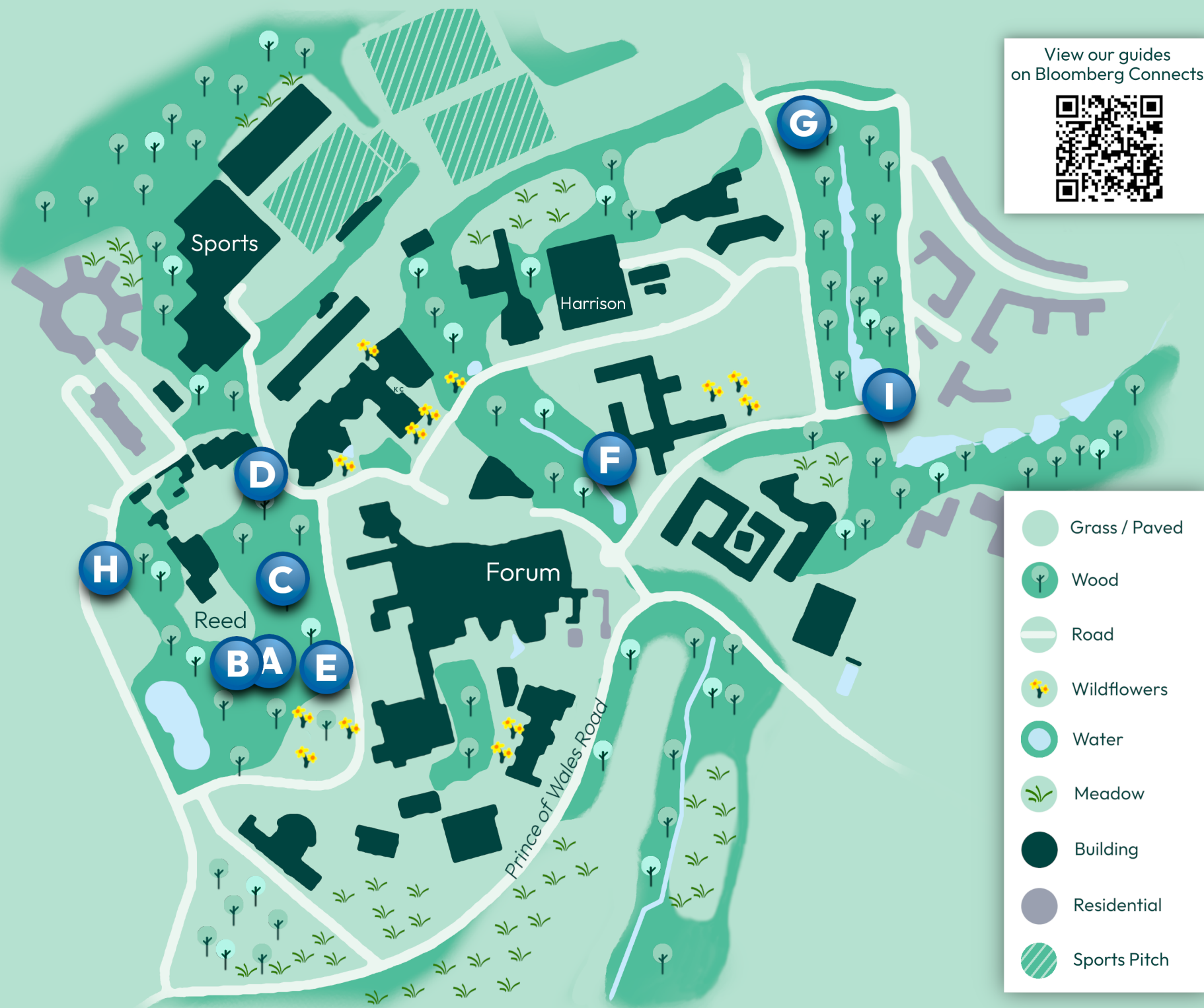

A *Torreya californica*

Location: Reed
What3Words: stick.lucky.drop
Coordinates: 50.73449, -3.53680
Champion of: Width (Devon)
Called a nutmeg tree
Listed as Vulnerable
From California

B *Juglans nigra*

Location: Reed
What3Words: wooden.just.thinks
Coordinates: 50.73463, -3.53713
Champion of: Width (Devon)
Known as Black Walnut
Dark brown timber; tasty fruits
From the USA

C *Quercus leucotrichophora*

Location: Reed
What3Words: less.secret.libraries
Coordinates: 50.73559, -3.53662
Champion of: Width + Height (Country)
Subtropical tree
Often used as firewood
Known as Banjh, or Ban

D *Catalpa x erubescens* 'J C Teas'

Location: Reed
What3Words: answer.reader.remark
Coordinates: 50.73610, -3.53662
Champion of: Width (Devon)
Hybrid cultivar
First discovered in Paris
Purple and green leaves

E *Pinus taeda*

Location: Reed
What3Words: insist.soon.clock
Coordinates: 50.73459, -3.53606
Champion of: Width + Height (Devon)
Southern Yellow Pine
Native to the USA
Used commercially

F *Eucalyptus gunnii*

Location: The Plantation
What3Words: shells.become.still
Coordinates: 50.73623, -3.53239
Champion of: Height (Devon)
From Tasmania
Known as White or Cider gum
Has beautiful leaves

G *Ulmus laevis*

Location: Taddiforde Valley
What3Words: buns.vows.only
Coordinates: 50.73894, -3.52993
Champion of: Height (Devon)
Native to Europe
Known as a Fluttering Elm
Lives along rivers

H *Pseudotsuga menziesii* var. *glauca*

Location: Reed
What3Words: prone.stove.rocket
Coordinates: 50.73525, -3.53883
Champion of: Width (Devon)
Lives for centuries
"Rocky Mountain Douglas Fir"
Named for blue needles

I *Sequoia sempervirens* 'Cantab'

Location: Taddiforde Valley
What3Words: smug.famous.deflection
Coordinates: 50.73657, -3.52896
Champion of: Width + Height (Devon)
Coast Redwood 'Cantab'
Named in 1977
From a mutation

Champion trees are considered the greatest of their species in the region. They are measured by a team of volunteers around the UK who support the Tree Register of Britain and Ireland (TROBI). The data gathered is useful for assessing growth, age, and survival, and is measured periodically.
