## 2. Applicant eligibility

Applicants who:

- are a citizen/passport holder of Bangladesh, Canada, China (mainland), Egypt, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Japan, Kenya, Malaysia, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, South Korea, Sri Lanka, Taiwan, Thailand, Türkiye, USA or Vietnam and therefore classed as an International student for fees purposes; and
- already hold an offer (conditional or unconditional) to study an eligible Postgraduate taught programme at the University of Exeter beginning in the 2027/28 academic year.

## 3. Programme eligibility

Scholarships are available for September 2027 entry for the University of Exeter's UK campus-based Postgraduate Taught degrees<sup>i</sup> in the following departments:

Administration (MPA) with Applied Study; Law programmes delivered by the University of Law, MA Law (SQE1), MA Law (Conversion), LLM Legal Practice (SQE 1&2), SQE Preparation Courses); MiPDAL Dual Masters in Intellectual Property Law; Postgraduate Certificates; Postgraduate Diplomas; Degree Apprenticeships. Fully online or distance learning programmes are also not eligible.

#### **4. Selection criteria**

These awards will be allocated automatically to eligible applicants applying for an eligible programme by 31 July 2027 for September 2027 entry (Round1) and 1 December 2027 for any eligible programmes open for January 2028 entry (Round 2). Awards may be allocated to late applicants at the University's discretion.

#### **5. Scholarship application process**

No scholarship application is required.

To accept an award, applicants should confirm their study place, paying their tuition fee deposit by the deadline in their programme offer letter.

This scholarship will be advised to the University's Confirmation for Acceptance for Studies (CAS) team as allocated.

Awards will be received by eligible applicants who go on to enrol at the University of Exeter on an eligible programme in 2027/28.

#### **6. Exclusions and Exceptions**

These scholarships are intended for self-funded students.

If your tuition fees will be financed by an external body (such as an overseas government or Chevening, Commonwealth or a partner Institution) with whom the University has a shared financing agreement then this award may be invalidated or superseded with a different fee arrangement.

It is your responsibility to inform us if you are in receipt of any external funding (other than personal loans) prior to enrolment, as this may affect your scholarship eligibility; please email a copy of the award letter to admissions [pg-ad@exeter.ac.uk](mailto:pg-ad@exeter.ac.uk)

You cannot normally receive more than one scholarship (tuition fees discount) from the University of Exeter; if you are offered multiple scholarships, then you will be awarded whichever scholarship has the higher value. Scholarships may only be combined where this is expressly permitted in the terms and conditions of, or the agreement for, the relevant award(s), and a cap may apply.

#### **7. Award payment**

If you defer your 2027/28 offer or change fee status, then your scholarship offer will be invalidated.

If you transfer to an ineligible programme, then your scholarship offer will be invalidated.

This scholarship will be awarded as a reduction in tuition fees; it cannot be paid as cash or attributed to other charges such as accommodation fees. It will be automatically deducted from your first-year tuition fees following enrolment. If you choose to pay your tuition fees in instalments, the award will be deducted from the total annual tuition fee and the remaining balance split accordingly.

Tuition fees deduction/s due are applied to your student account and show in your online statement within the first four weeks of study. Any awardees studying part time (under the relevant visa regulations) will receive the full Scholarship deduction in their first year. Where multiple awards have been offered, in line with the relevant exclusions and exceptions, ineligible scholarships may be removed during the first term of study.

In the event that you withdraw or interrupt your studies post enrolment then the University Finance regulations at that date will apply as regards any repayment, subsequent adjustments to fees or other requirements:
