

# Important Information – Terms and Conditions

University of Exeter Postgraduate Taught Scholarships 2025/26 for Bangladesh, Canada, Egypt, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Japan, Kenya, Malaysia, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Thailand, Turkey and Vietnam -January 2026 entry

The University of Exeter is offering scholarships to international students from Bangladesh, Canada, Egypt, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Japan, Kenya, Malaysia, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Thailand, Turkey and Vietnam. These scholarships help make sure aspiring students from these countries can pursue their chosen taught Masters degree and take their place in our thriving university community. Here, students will develop their academic skills for the future and contribute to a diverse student experience.

These awards are for one year only and are not recurrent for subsequent years of study.

## 2. Applicant eligibility

## Applicants who:

- are a citizen/passport holder of Bangladesh, Canada, Egypt, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Japan, Kenya, Malaysia, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Thailand, Turkey or Vietnam and therefore classed as an International student for fees purposes; and
- already hold an offer to study an eligible Postgraduate taught programme at the University of Exeter beginning in January 2026.

# 3. Programme eligibility

Scholarships are available for the following campus-based Postgraduate Taught degrees in the University of Exeter's Faculty of Environment Science and Economy:

- MSc Marketing Management

#### Computer Science

Only the programmes listed above are eligible. (Postgraduate Certificates, Postgraduate Diplomas, Degree Apprenticeships, fully online or distance learning programmes are not eligible.)

### 4. Selection criteria

These awards will be allocated automatically to eligible applicants applying for an eligible programme by 1 December 2025 for January 2026 entry.

# 5. Scholarship application process

No scholarship application is required.

To accept an award, applicants should confirm their study place, paying their tuition fee deposit by the deadline in their programme offer letter.

This scholarship will be included in the information in the Confirmation of Acceptance for Study (CAS) statement if applicable.

Awards will be received by eligible applicants who go on to enrol at the University of Exeter on an eligible programme for January 2026 entry .

## 6. Exclusions and Exceptions

These scholarships are intended for self-funded students.

If your tuition fees will be financed by an external body (such as an overseas government or Chevening, Commonwealth or a partner Institution) with whom the University has a shared financing agreement then this award may be invalidated or superseded with a different fee arrangement.

If you expect to receive funding from a charity this may also make you ineligible to receive this scholarship.

It is your responsibility to inform us if you are in receipt of any external funding prior to enrolment; please email a copy of the award letter to admissions pg-ad@exeter.ac.uk

You cannot normally receive more than one scholarship (tuition fee discount) from the University of Exeter; if you are eligible for multiple scholarships, then you will be awarded whichever scholarship has the higher value. However, the following exceptions apply for one year of study (for eligible programmes beginning in the 2025/26 academic year):

- Applicants eligible for an award under this University of Exeter Postgraduate Taught Scholarships 2025/26 scheme who are joining through an institutional progression agreement where a partial tuition fee discount is applied can receive both discounts, subject to a maximum award value of £10,000.
- Applicants eligible for an award under this University of Exeter Postgraduate Taught Scholarships 2025/26 scheme can receive this together with an Exeter Excellence Scholarships 2025/26 - Postgraduate Taught scheme award, subject to a maximum award value of £10,000.

Applicants allocated an award under this University of Exeter Postgraduate Taught Scholarships 2025/26 scheme for September 2025 entry and changing entry to January 2026 for the same programme remain eligible.

## 7. Award payment

If you defer your January 2026 offer or change fee status, then your scholarship offer will be invalidated.

If you transfer to an ineligible programme, then your scholarship offer will be invalidated.

This scholarship will be awarded as a reduction in tuition fees; it cannot be paid as cash or attributed to other charges such as accommodation fees. It will be automatically deducted from your first-year tuition fees following enrolment. If you choose to pay your tuition fees in instalments, the award will be deducted from the total annual tuition fee and the remaining balance split accordingly.

Tuition fees deduction/s due are applied to your student account and show in your online statement within the first four weeks of study. Any awardees studying part time (under the relevant visa regulations) will receive the full Scholarship deduction in their first year.
