The University of Exeter is offering scholarships to international students from Cambodia, China (mainland), Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Jordan, Philippines, South Korea, Türkiye and Vietnam. These scholarships help make sure aspiring students from these countries can pursue their chosen Undergraduate degree and take their place in our thriving university community. Here, students will develop their academic skills for the future and contribute to a diverse student experience.

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Recurring at the same value for each subsequent year of the Undergraduate degree for which the full tuition fees are due. This discount will not apply to study abroad, placement or repeat years.					
2. Applicant eligibility					
Applicants who: - are a citizen/passport holder of Cambodia, China (mainland), Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Jordan, Philippines, South Korea, Türkiye or Vietnam and therefore classed as an International student for fees purposes; and - already hold an offer (conditional or unconditional) to study an eligible Undergraduate programme at the University of Exeter, entering year one of that programme directly in September 2027. Students progressing from University of Exeter International Study Centre (ISC) International Foundation are not eligible.					
3. Programme eligibility					
Scholarships are available for the University of Exeter’s UK campus-based Undergraduate degrees in the following departments (including study abroad and industrial experience variants):

4. Selection criteria	
These awards will be allocated automatically to eligible applicants applying for an eligible programme by 30 June 2027 for 2027/28 entry.	
5. Scholarship application process	
No scholarship application is required. To accept an award, applicants should make the University of Exeter their Firm choice by their UCAS deadline. Awards cannot be allocated to applicants who have already made the University of Exeter their Insurance choice. This scholarship will be advised to the University's Confirmation for Acceptance for Studies (CAS) team as allocated.	

Awards will be received by eligible applicants who are placed at the University of Exeter and enrol on an eligible programme in 2027/28.

6. Exclusions and Exceptions

These scholarships are intended for self-funded students.

If your tuition fees will be financed by an external body (such as an overseas government or a partner Institution) with whom the University has a shared financing agreement, then this award may be invalidated or superseded with a different fee arrangement.

It is your responsibility to inform us if you are in receipt of any external funding prior to enrolment, as this may affect your scholarship eligibility; please email a copy of the award letter to admissions: ug-ad@exeter.ac.uk

You cannot normally receive more than one scholarship (tuition fees discount) from the University of Exeter; if you are offered multiple scholarships, then you will be awarded whichever scholarship has the higher value. Scholarships may only be combined where this is expressly permitted in the terms and conditions of, or the agreement for, the relevant award(s), and a cap may apply.

7. Award payment

If you defer your 2027/28 offer or change fee status, then your scholarship offer will be invalidated.

If you transfer to an ineligible programme, then your scholarship offer will be invalidated.

This scholarship will be awarded as a reduction in tuition fees; it cannot be paid as cash or attributed to other charges such as accommodation fees. It will be automatically deducted from your first year tuition fees following enrolment. If you choose to pay your tuition fees in instalments, the award will be deducted from the total annual tuition fee and the remaining balance split accordingly.

Tuition fees deduction/s due are applied to your student account and show in your online statement within the first four weeks of study. Any awardees studying part time (under the relevant visa regulations) will receive the full Scholarship deduction in the first part of each whole year. Where multiple awards have been offered, in line with the relevant exclusions and exceptions, ineligible scholarships may be removed during the first term of study.

In the event that you withdraw or interrupt your studies post enrolment then the University Finance regulations at that date will apply as regards any repayment, subsequent adjustments to fees or other requirements:
