



Important Information – Terms and Conditions

The Exeter MBA (Online) Innovation Cohort Scholarship 2026/27

The University of Exeter is pleased to offer an exclusive scholarship to applicants who become part of the innovative cohorts of The Exeter MBA (Online), recognising their role in being the first to shape this exciting new programme.

1. Award Amount

The scholarship is worth 20% (£4,620) of the tuition fees for The Exeter MBA (Online) for the 2026/27 academic year.

This award is for one year only (or the equivalent of one full-time year when studying part-time).

2. Applicant eligibility

All applicants holding an offer (conditional or unconditional) for entry to The Exeter MBA (Online) in the 2026/27 academic year are eligible for this scholarship.

This scholarship is therefore available for entrants to this programme in September 2026, January 2027 and May 2027. Applicants joining cohorts from September 2027 onwards will not be eligible.

3. Programme eligibility

This scholarship is available for The Exeter MBA (Online) for entry in the 2026/27 academic year on a part-time basis.

No other programmes are eligible.

4. Selection criteria

These scholarships will be allocated automatically to offer holders for The Exeter MBA (Online) 2026/27 cohorts.

5. Scholarship application process

No scholarship application is required.

To accept this award, applicants should firmly accept their offer of study for The Exeter MBA (Online) for September 2026, January 2027 or May 2027 entry.

Awards will be received by offer holders who enrol on The Exeter MBA (Online) in the 2026/27 academic year.

The University's decision on whether to award this scholarship is final; there is no appeal process.

6. Exclusions and Exceptions

These scholarships are intended for self-funded students.

If your tuition fees will be financed by an external body (such as an overseas government or a partner Institution) with whom the University has a shared financing agreement, then this award may be invalidated or superseded with a different fee arrangement.

If you expect to receive funding from a charity this may also make you ineligible to receive this scholarship.

It is your responsibility to inform us if you are in receipt of any external funding prior to enrolment; please email a copy of the award letter to online@exeter.ac.uk.

You cannot normally receive more than one scholarship (tuition fees discount) from the University of Exeter; if you are offered multiple scholarships, then you will be awarded whichever scholarship has the higher value.

The University reserves the right to vary or withdraw this scholarship scheme at its sole discretion.

7. Award payment

If you defer your offer for The Exeter MBA (Online) from the September 2026, January 2027, or May 2027 intake to an intake beyond the 2026/27 academic year, then your scholarship offer will be invalidated.

If you transfer to an ineligible programme, then your scholarship offer will be invalidated.

This scholarship will be awarded as a reduction in tuition fees; it cannot be paid as cash or attributed to other charges. It will be automatically deducted from your tuition fees following enrolment.

Tuition fees deduction/s due are applied to your student account and show in your online statement. Awardees studying part-time will receive the full scholarship deduction (20% of the full-time tuition fees for The Exeter MBA (Online) for the 2026/27 academic year). How this is applied may vary with the payment option selected and will be advised individually.

Where multiple awards have been offered, in line with the relevant exclusions and exceptions, ineligible scholarships may be removed during the first term of study.

In the event that you withdraw or interrupt your studies post enrolment then the University Finance regulations at that date will apply as regards any repayment, subsequent adjustments to fees or other requirements: <http://www.exeter.ac.uk/students/finance/studentfinanceregulations/>.

8. Other
